Men and women who visit in private homes, health facilities, and care homes to bring Holy Communion, prayer, and comfort to those unable to attend Mass.

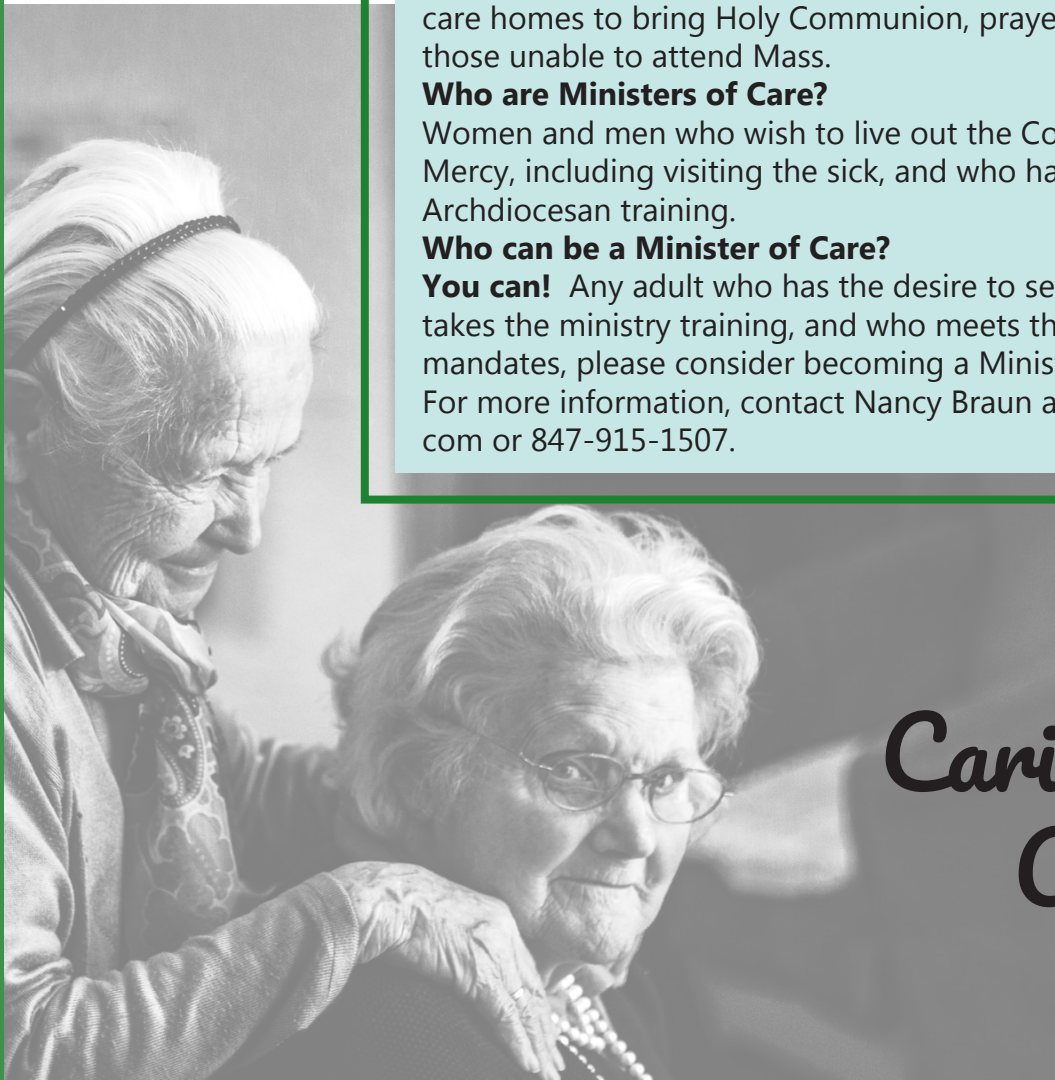
Who are Ministers of Care?

WEEKLY INTENTIONS

CHANGES COMING TO MASS INTENTIONS: On January 1, 2022 we will be making changes to our mass intentions. Four take-aways to keep in mind:

- 1.) Intentions don't have to be for the deceased; you can also ask that a Mass be offered up in thanksgiving for a birthday, anniversary or other worthy causes. Please do indicate if it is for someone deceased.
- 2.) No more than four intentions will be remembered at each mass. Sunday intentions will be assigned to a specific mass as requested.
- 3.) Mass intentions are a free-will donation, but it's customary to donate \$10/mass.
- 4.) Request an intention at least two weeks ahead of time for a specific date.
