

A MESSAGE FROM...

Dear Parishioners,

As you may know, Jubilation 2021, "Amazing Grace," has been postponed until Fall 2022. Over the last 25 years, proceeds from this important fundraiser have been directed where they are needed most, here and abroad. Proceeds from previous Jubilation events have gone to PADS, St. Vincent de Paul, tuition assistance for our school and religious education



programs, and parish ministries that care for those in our community and around the world.

These needs are ever-present as the world moves forward in faith. With that in mind, we have developed an exciting alternative to Jubilation this year, with the assistance of 2021 Chair-Couple Mike and Krista Coleman, called "The Jubilation Envelope Challenge."

The Jubilation Envelope Challenge will have 500 virtual 'envelopes' available to be sponsored by our parishioners. Envelopes will be assigned a value from \$1.00 to \$500.00 – each envelope increasing in value by \$1.00 increments up to and including \$500.00. Everyone will have the opportunity to sponsor an envelope - or more than one – if you are able. By sponsoring an envelope, you are pledging to 'return' that envelope along with the donation as indicated by the envelope chosen. If each envelope is sponsored and returned, our very generous community will have raised \$125,000.00!

We decided to make the envelopes virtual so that those who cannot attend Mass in-person will be able to participate. More details about participating in this key fundraiser will be announced in upcoming bulletins. Stay tuned for the launch! 
