Everyone deserves to be in safe, healthy relationships. If you, or someone you know, may be in an abusive relationship, a path to safety exists. Get help.



Matthew 25:31-40. I urge you to read that Gospel passage.

As a life-long member of this parish, I have seen the wonderful way that our St. James community lives out that Gospel message from St. Matthew. We have an incredible number of ministries, led by dedicated parishioners, that do a tireless amount of work. Whether it is St. Vincent de Paul, PADS, Loaves and Fishes, all the way to the Family and School Association within the school···truly, our parish feeds the hungry, gives drink to the thirsty, welcomes strangers, clothes the naked, and cares for those that are ill.

This month, the Stepping Stones Ministry is raising awareness around those who are imprisoned... imprisoned by domestic violence. Many people, even here within our own parish, are imprisoned by domestic violence or knows of somebody imprisoned by this vioence. Perhaps you have noticed the trees on our beautiful campus adorned with large purple ribbons. This is but one way that the Stepping Stones Ministry is bringing attention to the issue of domestic violence.

Another, more powerful, way Stepping Stones Ministry gives voice to domestic violence this weekend is through it's Clothesline Project. You may have noticed several paper t-shirts with different colors hanging in our Gathering Space. Each color represents a different type of domestic violence. Whether it be red for sexual assault, yellow for dating violence, blue for child abuse, or purple for domestic violence, I along with the Stepping Stones Ministry, urge you to take the time to write the first name of somebody you know who has been imprisoned by any of these types of violence on one of the t-shirts. By writing their name you are symbolically 'visiting' them in their prison of violence. And then, I urge you to lift that person(s) up in prayer, that they may be freed from their particular prison.

I have been personally impacted by domestic violence, and I urge us all to pray for those who have been impacted by domestic violence as well. Let us shine a light on this darkness and work to bring an end to it.

Thank you for joining us in remembering joining us in prayer and joining us in ending domestic violence.
