

This Sunday, as the Church completes the liturgical year, we mark the Solemnity of Christ the King. In Quas Primas, the document establishing this feast almost 100 years ago, Pope Pius XI wrote this:

"He must reign in our minds, which should assent with perfect submission and firm belief to revealed truths and to the doctrines of Christ. He must reign in our wills, which should obey the laws and precepts of God. He must reign in our hearts, which should spurn natural desires and love God above all things and cleave to him alone. He must reign in our bodies and in our members, which should serve as instruments for the interior sanctification of our souls, or to use the words of the Apostle Paul, 'as instruments of justice unto God.'"

The Mexican martyrs of the last century proclaimed as they went to their deaths "Viva Cristo Rey!" (Long live Christ the King!)

### LITURGY + WORSHIP

With the change of liturgical year comes a change in focus from Mark to Luke. Unlike Mark's account, the Gospel according to Luke is paired with Luke's second volume, the Acts of the Apostles.

Luke's Gospel is home to some of the most beloved scenes (the annunciations, the nativity scene, etc.) and some of the most iconic characters (the good Samaritan, the Galilean women, the prodigal son/father, the "unjust" steward, Zacchaeus, etc.). Perhaps more than any of the other evangelists, Luke dramatizes the story of salvation and focuses on how the narrative of Jesus and the Church is a faithful continuation of the drama of Israel.

As we begin a re-reading of Luke this Advent, it might help to focus on how Luke adds to or changes what we heard over this past year of Mark. Seeing multiple perspectives will help us to refine our own, so that we might be faithful evangelists in our own time and place.

### **During Advent**

we are in a state of wonderment and mystery as we await the coming of the Christ Child.

The liturgical music reflects a sense of mystery with restrained joy. Our music is with a sense of watching, waiting, and anticipation. Our souls in stillness are waiting for Emmanuel, God with Us, to come and share in the hope of His love and His pure light. May the Savior of the nations come and show us His glory this Advent Season!
