





### January is Human Trafficking Awareness Month

*Sex-trafficking involves the use of force, fraud, or coercion to obtain a commercial sex act. Millions of men, women, and children are sexually exploited worldwide. Trafficking can happen in every community, and victims can be of any age, social status, race, gender, or nationality.*

The St. James Resource Center, open during parish office hours, offers the following materials to help you become more educated on this global issue. You are welcome to borrow these resources.

#### DVDs:

*Nefarious: Merchant of Souls* (2011)

This video crosses 19 countries - telling the stories of traffickers, victims & survivors, as well as efforts of individuals & organizations working to end this form of abuse. Unrated. Recommended for adults and mature teens.

*Look Beneath the Surface: Identifying Victims of Human Trafficking in the U.S.* (2006)

This brief video, presented by the US Department of Health and Human Services, provides information on trafficking and identifying & assisting victims.

#### Books:

*Trafficked: My Story* by Sophie Hayes (2012)

This book offers a first-person account of a young British girl's journey into & out of the world of sex trafficking.

*Human Trafficking: A Reference Handbook* by Alexis A. Aronowitz (2017)

This Contemporary World Series text presents an extensive exploration of the topic of human trafficking. It examines the history of slavery and factors contributing to its proliferation.
