

FORMING DISCIPLES

Be Disciples. Make Disciples. This is the mission here at St. James. I think it is important that we define the word "Disciple". A Disciple literally means "one who follows another for the purpose of learning". One who sits at the feet of the master. Who is the master in our case? Jesus Christ. Of course our world is different. We have social media, vehicles, and the ability to communicate with anyone all over the world at any given time. But we are called to holiness just as the Disciples were 2,000 years ago.



Here are five tips to growing in faith and discipleship in 2020. Keep in mind...God is patient with us He knows our hearts and knows when we are trying to love Him better...

1. *Read the Bible daily.* Even if it is 1 verse or 1 chapter. Immerse yourself in the Word of God and watch your life transform.
2. *Mass every week.* We cannot give what we do not have. Each week we get to fill our very bodies with the life of Jesus in the Eucharist and then we get to share Him with others throughout the week.
3. *Forgive.* St. Augustine put it bluntly, "If you are suffering from a bad man's injustice, forgive him, lest there be two bad men." Forgiveness is freeing.
4. *Learn.* We have many ways for you to grow in faith here at St. James. Alpha, foundations, bible studies, retreats, BYOB, and more. Seek to know the Lord and let us know how we can help.
5. *Let yourself be loved.* This is big. We often feel unworthy. Jesus washes away our unworthiness in Baptism and on the cross. God loves us right in our mess. His grace is amazing.

I pray that we can continue to be disciples and make disciples here at St. James in 2020 and know that my prayers are always with you.


