A MESSAGE FROM...

He descended into hell. 🤖

We've been saying it for weeks now as we recite the Apostles' Creed during Sunday liturgies. I bet this line makes some cringe—even to the point of preventing people from saying it. So we should ask: what could this statement possibly mean, and why has it been enshrined in our creed?



The first thing to be said is that “hell” here is not referring to the state of eternal damnation that we as Catholics believe to exist, even if perhaps no one is enduring it (since the Church has never once definitively affirmed that any person is in this hell).

Rather, “hell” in the Creed is referring to what in Hebrew is Sheol or in Greek Hades—basically the “realm of the dead” or the “underworld,” where people weren't really alive but just shadows of sorts. It's important to note that by and large in the Old Testament, hell is death because death separates a person from all other people and from God, since God's love doesn't seem to penetrate the realm of the dead. This hell may be likened to a feeling of intense loneliness, the complete opposite of togetherness or communion.

Therein lies the important point. We see that Jesus endured this utter separation and loneliness. Think of his cry from the cross: My God, my God, why have you abandoned me? In letting himself be brought into this state of radical isolation, he is showing us that in fact God's love does penetrate even the realm of the dead, something thought to be impenetrable. He's reversing the Old Testament understanding that death = hell, and he's revealing that even in death there is life, since his love now dwells even there.

If he hadn't gone to the very lowest place (lowest in the sense of most isolated, not in a physical sense), his love would have a limit, and our own death would be true isolation. But knowing that Christ died our death is knowing that there's a divine partner waiting to accompany us through our own death, whenever that happens.

That's why we shouldn't be afraid. And even more, it's why we shouldn't shudder when we profess that he descended into hell.

Dear St. James Parishioners,

In a few days, thanks to your incredible generosity, work will begin to refurbish our bell tower and steeple. After nearly seventy years of service calling us to Mass, playing hymns, tolling for our departed loved ones, and telling us the time of day, it is time to do some structural repairs and cosmetic updating. The work is expected to take about three months to complete. Below is some information that you may find useful regarding the project:



- Scaffolding will be installed approximately the week of April 12 and will be located on all four sides of the bell tower.
- Work will begin the week of April 19, pending permit from the village.
- A small area of the parking lot between the church and the rectory will be fenced off for use as a staging area; eight parking spaces in this fenced area will not be available.
- The northwest door to the church will have a protected tunnel in the scaffolding; that door will remain available for entry into and out of the church.
- During workdays, the Arlington Hts. Rd. doors will not be open for use. And to keep us safe, the area outside these doors will be roped off and the doors inside the church will be cordoned off, as well.
- The Arlington Hts. Rd. doors will be available on non-workdays and on weekends.
- Normal work hours will be 7AM-3:30 PM; no work is planned for weekends.
- There will typically be two or three crew members on-site as space is very tight in the work area.
- The work crew will access the bell tower using the scaffolding vs. through the church.
- Construction noise will cease during Masses, wakes, funerals, and any other liturgical events in the worship space.
