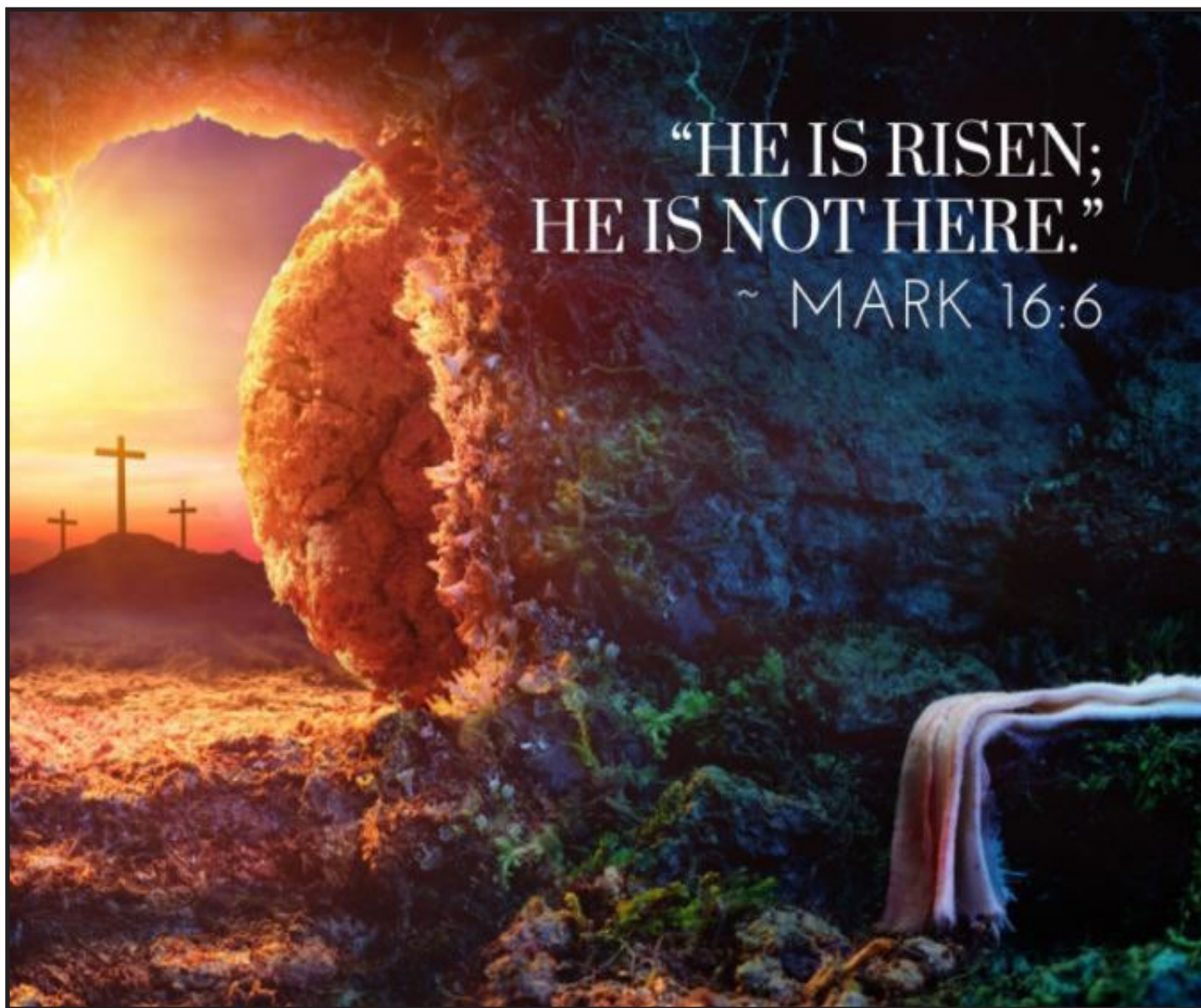

# A MESSAGE FROM...

Dear Parishioners,

Today is Good Friday, and we're sending out the Easter Sunday bulletin. There goes St. James with a false start.

But we at St. James are just observing liturgical time. You probably don't need me to tell you this, but I will anyway because I need to fill some space: Good Friday, Holy Saturday, and Easter Sunday constitute the Triduum. Of course, we began the celebration last night (our Thursday) because we're following the Jewish custom of beginning the day at sundown and not midnight.



So if you're reading this anytime up till sundown on April 4, then you're reading it on the Triduum. Time gets complicated in the church world, doesn't it? (It's not the only thing...)

At any rate, what we do during the Triduum is one extended living-out of the Paschal Mystery. We commemorate the handing over of Jesus (first by himself in the Last Supper, then by the people in his trial and crucifixion); then we keep the sabbath (Saturday) by waiting vigilantly in prayer and hope; and finally, we witness the light of Christ break into the darkness of (our) Saturday night and lead us into the joy of a bright Easter day.

This pattern of suffering-death-expectation-resurrection is woven into who we are as people. We all experience suffering and will someday experience our own death. What makes our suffering and death "worth" something is that we know, through what we celebrate these days, that they are leading us to resurrection.

I am most grateful that I can celebrate and meditate on these "sacred mysteries" with this faith-filled family of St. James, and I'm especially humbled to see all the hard work from musicians, liturgists, ministers, and staff to make our celebrations that much more reverent and joyful.

My prayer for these holy days is that we might together catch sight of the light of the resurrection—today, tomorrow, or Sunday—and help it to reach deep into any darkness we encounter, even death itself.

Have a blessed Triduum!
