# A MESSAGE FROM...

## "Sir, give us this bread always"

Over the past weeks we have been reading at mass through the Book of Exodus, telling the story of the Israelites escaping slavery in Egypt and traveling to the Promised Land. In today's reading, God responds to the hunger of the people by showering down manna from Heaven. This bread satisfies the physical need of the people for nourishment. Jesus, in John's Gospel, refers to this manna, saying "my Father gives you the true bread from heaven. For the bread of God is that which comes down from heaven and gives life to the world."



Just as he spoke to the woman at the well about life-giving water which will satisfy all thirst, Jesus now speaks to his disciples about the true Bread from Heaven – Himself. "I am the bread of life; whoever comes to me will never hunger, and whoever believes in me will never thirst." He is offering a transition from bread that fills us physically to the Bread of Heaven which feeds us spiritually. In the Eucharist, Jesus' sacrificial offering of his life to the Father is made present to us and is then offered to us as food, a different kind of food, Jesus' own Body and Blood.

This is what really matters. Over the past year and a half there was so much fear for our physical health that sometimes we may have lost sight of what is truly important – our spiritual health and life. I remember a moral theology professor who said, "we are not vitalists." In other words, although we respect and defend and care for human life, there is something more – supernatural life. Jesus proclaimed to the disciples, "I am the bread of life; whoever comes to me will never hunger, and whoever believes in me will never thirst."




