Dear fellow disciples,

I have a feeling that most parishes can't recite their own mission statement from memory, usually because it's a paragraph or several bullet points. Not so at our beloved St. James! Our mission statement in its most basic form requires memorization of two easy verbs and one noun: *Be disciples. Make disciples.*

It's worth focusing on that one noun. What does it mean to be a **disciple**? It would be nice and easy if it meant just saying "Lord, Lord," or using some other spiritual jargon and calling it a day. Unfortunately, that's not the case (see Mt 7:21). Being a disciple involves a lifelong commitment to doing the will of God. But it's hard to do the will of God if we don't know what the will of God is.

That's where being a disciple comes in. "Disciple" comes from the Latin word for "learn." What this implies for us, if we're true to our mission, is that we have to be a community of lifelong learners in order to be a community of lifelong teachers and witnesses. We cannot effectively evangelize the modern world with only an eighth-grade or high-school religious education, just as we likely wouldn't be able to practice law without going to law school or work in accounting without getting a degree in accounting.

This is why I'm happy to announce that we'll have some exciting new opportunities right here at St. James to continue to grow in our knowledge and practice of the faith. Here's a little menu of some of the adult formation opportunities this year:

- 1. BYOB: Bible 101. A series designed to give an overview of the Bible—how it's organized, how we can interpret it, how we can begin to appreciate some of its most important themes and figures. This series is scheduled for the 1st & 3rd Tuesdays of each month at 7pm in the Laramie Room, beginning September 1st.
- 2. BYOB: The Gospel of Mark. A reprise of last year's Tuesday night BYOB for those who prefer a morning time. This series will run on the 2nd & 4th Thursdays of each month at 9am in the Laramie Room, beginning September 10th.
- 3. The Miniseries. For those who can't commit to an ongoing series like BYOB but who still want to engage in some adult formation. The Miniseries will consist of 2–3 consecutive nights of exploration of one theological or spiritual topic (e.g., science & spirituality, social justice, sacraments, prayer, etc.). You could attend as few or as many of these miniseries as you'd like. They won't be cumulative, so Miniseries 2 won't build on Miniseries 1. Save the dates for Miniseries 1: September 28, 29, 30 at 7pm in the Laramie Room.

For each of these, we'll have room for 50 people in person (registration information TBA), and we will be live-streaming each session for viewers who aren't comfortable coming to the Laramie Room. It's my sincere hope that at least one of these options will give you an opportunity to become a more committed learner (err...disciple) so that you can help others to do the same. LAST CHANCE MASS



JUBILATION FAQS

Q: Who Can Host a Jubilation House Party?

A: We encourage anyone comfortable having a party, therefore, having people inside your home on Saturday night November 7th, to consider hosting. We foresee wonderful gatherings of ministry friends, class reunions, book clubs, or family/friend celebrations such as a birthday, retirement, or anniversary. You can theme your party however you want. We are excited to see the creativity!

Q: How many guests does a Jubilation House Party host invite?

A: We are basing parties on groups of 10. But, you can have more people or fewer people—whatever your comfort level. For each 10 people you host, Jubilation will provide a \$250 gift card to offset party expenses and two Raffle tickets for a chance at three fabulous prizes! (Hint: iPhone!)

Q: As a host or a party guest, how are tickets purchased?

A: Hosts and guests purchase tickets via the online invitation that will be emailed on September 9th. Hosts can opt to pay for their guests (10-pack=\$1000), or each guest buys their own ticket at \$100 each. Each registered guest (whether the host buys or the guest buys) will have access to the silent auction website to view/bid on items. Email and phone numbers will be required at the time of purchase to enable this.

Q: What if I am unable or uncomfortable attending a house party? Can I still participate?

A: Definitely. These are uncertain times, and for some people we understand that staying home is a great option. Anyone can purchase a \$100 ticket to participate in the silent auction and Fr. Matt's 8:30 pm ZOOM call regardless of where you are the night of November 7th.

Q: If I am new to Jubilation or do not know anyone hosting, how can I attend a house party?

A: All are welcome at Jubilation! Just let us know and we will arrange a location for you.

Q: I know that I want to host! What do I do now?


ST. JAMES SCHOOL




