At a recent backyard dinner, I had the opportunity to hit a whiffle ball with a whiffle bat. This simple action brought absolute joy to Robby, a two-year-old grandchild, who was hanging out with his grandparents. Young Robby was absolutely enthralled with chasing the ball and counting one, two, three...as I swung the bat, making contact with the ball.

Mindlessly, I drove that whiffle ball into the corners of the yard. Robby never lost interest and encouraged me to keep playing with him. After our picnic dinner, I felt a tug on my back. It was Robby with his bat and ball counting one, two, three. He wanted me to engage in the same simple ritual, and I quickly returned to the game. For a short while I felt renewed in mind and soul. This activity was good and pleasing and perfect.

Later that evening, the adults did what adults usually do, we talked about current events. The joy of Robby's earlier enthusiasm dissipated as we delved into the tough subjects of our world. All of us took turns citing opinions, facts, and articles of higher learning. It was not a contentious conversation; however, it wasn't really anything new nor earth shattering.

As I drove away that evening, I did not turn on the radio or make a phone call. I maintained the silence and took some time to reflect. I thought about how much energy I spend reading and researching trying to adapt to this current age.

In reflection, it became clear to me that the highlight of the evening was playing whiffle ball. I was quiet and focused on Robby's joy and innocence. That time away from social concerns, current events, and the sharing opinions opened a world that I believe was holy and pleasing to God.

I pray that in your daily routines you find a place of quiet or gratuitous pursuit that can transform your mind. Seeking the will of God is what is good and pleasing and perfect. It took a 2-year-old and whiffle ball game to help me find renewal of mind.

### JUBILATION FAQS

### Q: Who Can Host a Jubilation House Party?

A: We encourage anyone comfortable having a party, therefore, having people inside your home on Saturday night November 7th, to consider hosting. We foresee wonderful gatherings of ministry friends, class reunions, book clubs, or family/friend celebrations such as a birthday, retirement, or anniversary. You can theme your party however you want. We are excited to see the creativity!

### Q: How many guests does a Jubilation House Party host invite?

A: We are basing parties on groups of 10. But, you can have more people or fewer people—whatever your comfort level. For each 10 people you host, Jubilation will provide a \$250 gift card to offset party expenses and two Raffle tickets for a chance at three fabulous prizes! (Hint: iPhone!)

### Q: As a host or a party guest, how are tickets purchased?

A: Hosts and guests purchase tickets via the online invitation that will be emailed on September 9th. Hosts can opt to pay for their guests (10-pack=\$1000), or each guest buys their own ticket at \$100 each. Each registered guest (whether the host buys or the guest buys) will have access to the silent auction website to view/bid on items. Email and phone numbers will be required at the time of purchase to enable this.

### Q: What if I am unable or uncomfortable attending a house party? Can I still participate?

A: Definitely. These are uncertain times, and for some people we understand that staying home is a great option. Anyone can purchase a \$100 ticket to participate in the silent auction and Fr. Matt's 8:30 pm ZOOM call regardless of where you are the night of November 7th.

### Q: If I am new to Jubilation or do not know anyone hosting, how can I attend a house party?

A: All are welcome at Jubilation! Just let us know and we will arrange a location for you.




