

Dear St. James,

The sixth chapter of St. John's Gospel is filled with beautiful Eucharistic theology. We get a portion of it today.

"I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world." John 6:51



It is astounding to me that many Christians who say they are "Bible believers" pass over John chapter 6 and ignore these beautiful and profound words of Jesus about the Eucharist.

We have an immensely powerful and life-changing reality in the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist. God Himself comes to us and feeds us with His Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity.

An indispensable element of receiving Holy Communion is that we give ourselves totally to Him, holding nothing back. If we are holding something back, like the rich young man in the Gospel, we might retreat from Jesus in shame. He doesn't want us to be ashamed, but to pour out our hearts to Him, and to receive the love he desires for us.




