


SAINT JAMES PARISH ARLINGTON HEIGHTS

Since reopening on a limited scale, St. James has had many happy days. Each Mass is an extraordinary moment for the entire parish, but we have also had the joy of seeing several other sacraments take place. We have begun to celebrate baptisms and weddings that were delayed due to Covid-19. Our First Communicants have finally received Holy Communion. We were able to celebrate the sacrament of Confirmation. The RCIA candidates have been fully initiated into the Church, months after they were scheduled to do so during Holy Week.



I too, am waiting. I was scheduled to be ordained a transitional deacon this past May. After my own time of eager anticipation, the happy day has nearly arrived. This Wednesday, August 12, I will be finally be ordained!

In witnessing the sacraments and celebrations mentioned above, I began to appreciate the wide variety of vocations that each of us has. There is a common link to all our vocations. That is to love Jesus and to live intimately with him in our families, in our community, and in our profession. Whether priests or parents, accountants or contractors, students or retirees; we are called to live lives intimately in communion with Jesus.

One of the most moving moments of the Rite of Ordination is the litany of the saints. During this litany, the men to be ordained lay prostrate before the bishop and the community. The community chants the litany asking the saints to intercede on our behalf. We hear the names of many great saints. They are men and women, priests and religious, married and single, young and old. Each of us is called to holiness and sainthood. And each of us is called to support each other in that journey. Together, we achieve holiness and communion by fully embracing the Lord wherever we may be.

When I lay prostrate on the floor of the Immaculate Conception Chapel at Mundelein Seminary on ordination day, please know that I will be thinking of you and praying for you. I will pray that each of you continually grow closer to the Lord and strive toward holiness. As the litany of saints is chanted, I will pray for them to intercede for you also and serve as a guide toward holiness in your own particular vocation. Please pray for me as well.

JUBILATION FAQS

Q: Who Can Host a Jubilation House Party?

A: We encourage anyone comfortable having a party, therefore, having people inside your home on Saturday night November 7th, to consider hosting. We foresee wonderful gatherings of ministry friends, class reunions, book clubs, or family/friend celebrations such as a birthday, retirement, or anniversary. You can theme your party however you want. We are excited to see the creativity!

Q: How many guests does a Jubilation House Party host invite?

A: We are basing parties on groups of 10. But, you can have more people or fewer people—whatever your comfort level. For each 10 people you host, Jubilation will provide a \$250 gift card to offset party expenses and two Raffle tickets for a chance at three fabulous prizes! (Hint: iPhone!)

Q: As a host or a party guest, how are tickets purchased?

A: Hosts and guests purchase tickets via the online invitation that will be emailed on September 9th. Hosts can opt to pay for their guests (10-pack=\$1000), or each guest buys their own ticket at \$100 each. Each registered guest (whether the host buys or the guest buys) will have access to the silent auction website to view/bid on items. Email and phone numbers will be required at the time of purchase to enable this.

Q: What if I am unable or uncomfortable attending a house party? Can I still participate?

A: Definitely. These are uncertain times, and for some people we understand that staying home is a great option. Anyone can purchase a \$100 ticket to participate in the silent auction and Fr. Matt's 8:30 pm ZOOM call regardless of where you are the night of November 7th.

Q: If I am new to Jubilation or do not know anyone hosting, how can I attend a house party?

A: All are welcome at Jubilation! Just let us know and we will arrange a location for you.

Q: I know that I want to host! What do I do now?

A: Wonderful and thank you! Think about your party, pick a theme, and talk to people you want to invite. Let them know the date and intent of this fundraiser. Advise that the ticket price is \$100 OR if you plan to purchase their ticket. If you intend to purchase their ticket, gather their cell number and email address for registration time. If they buy their own ticket, a space will be available at the time of registration to put HOST name.

Q: Anything special a host needs to do at or for their party?

A: Yes! Hosts should have support for this fundraising effort and encourage silent auction bidding by their guests throughout the evening. Make it fun! 
