A MESSAGE FROM...

“Fr Matt, what are you doing? What is a Sabbatical?”

I am in the midst of planning a sixth month sabbatical which will allow me to pray, study and visit my family. My first reaction is gratitude. This sabbatical is a gift from the people of St. James and the Archdiocese of Chicago to gain new insight and inspiration before taking on a new assignment in Lake or Cook County. Taking a sabbatical, beginning in January, allows me to enter the cycle of new priest assignments next July.



I arrived stateside after my fourth deployment in Afghanistan on Memorial Day weekend of 2013. On August 15, 2013 I began as your servant and pastor. I have been blessed every single day praying and serving with St. James parishioners. Having served as a priest for 31 years, I feel a great sense of peace at St. James and very much at home at St. James on Arlington Heights Road.

With the current Covid-19 guidelines my sabbatical plans are currently in a state of flux. My hope is to spend some time in a retreat house, possibly participate in a 30-day silent retreat, participate in mission service, and visit my family in California, New Jersey, and Georgia. I would like to report that I was going to be somewhere incredibly exotic. With the current state of caution, I may end up in Lake County for six months. God's grace will be present wherever I am able to visit.

Reflecting on many of the people I have been blessed to serve, I realize most have not had six days much less six months to pause in their vocations. The opportunity to revitalize soul and mind is a tremendous gift. Know that I will be at St. James through the end of the year. I remain honored and humbled to be your pastor.

Bring Light to Dark Times

Did you know that the **Invest in Kids Act** helps children from low-income households in Illinois access scholarships that cover up to 100 percent of a Catholic school's tuition? Thousands of students are gaining knowledge and building on their faith in Archdiocese of Chicago Catholic Schools thanks to this program. What is a tax credit scholarship?



Attention 70 ½-Year-Olds....Have You Heard the Good News?

Many parishioners who are required to make yearly Required Minimum Distributions (RMDs) have been satisfying their RMD and directly making a charitable contribution to St. James using a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD). A QCD allows IRA owners who are age 70 ½ or older to directly transfer up to \$100,000 annually from an IRA to charity, tax free.

Now during the pandemic, the IRS has *waived* the RMDs for 2020 via the Cares Act. Therefore, some taxpayers may think that they can no longer (in 2020) make charitable contributions using QCDs, or that doing so will not give them the same tax advantages as before. This is not true. The **good news** is that taxpayers who could otherwise make charitable contributions using QCDs can still do so. QCDs will still be excluded from gross taxable income, adjusted gross income, and taxable income as before. So taxpayers who are eligible to make QCDs, including those newly eligible for 2020, should strongly consider using QCDs for making their charitable contributions to St. James in 2020.

Remember, by using QCDs, and not having to include this distribution in your adjusted gross income, taxpayers can potentially avoid the loss of exemptions, deductions, credits and phase outs, AMT (alternative minimum tax), the 3.8% surtax on net investment income, and the increase in Social Security premiums for Medicare Part B and Part D.

A win-win for using QCDs! *Please consult your tax advisor for your individual financial circumstances.*

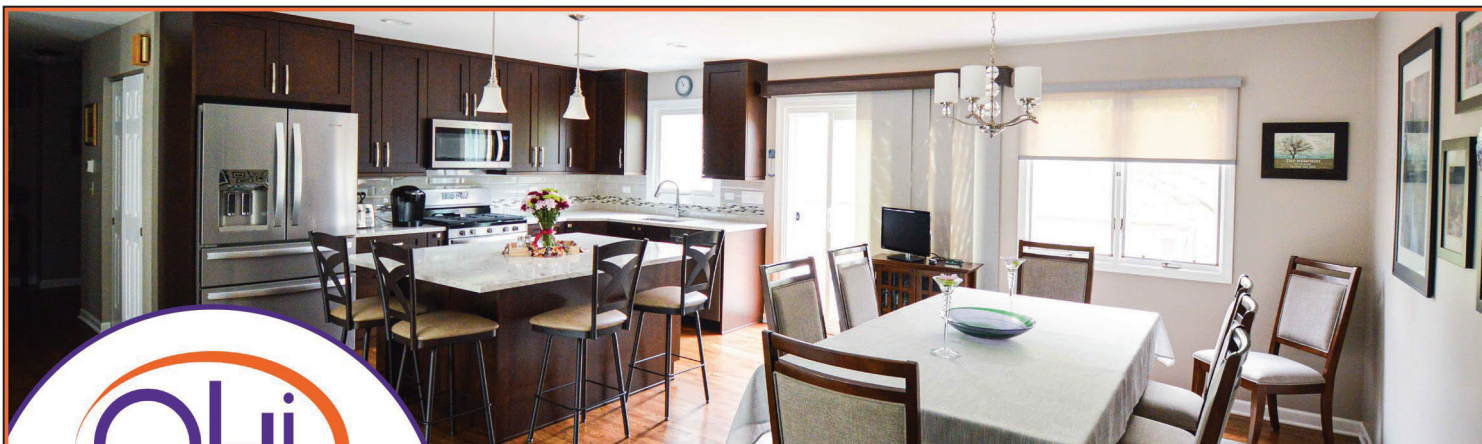
