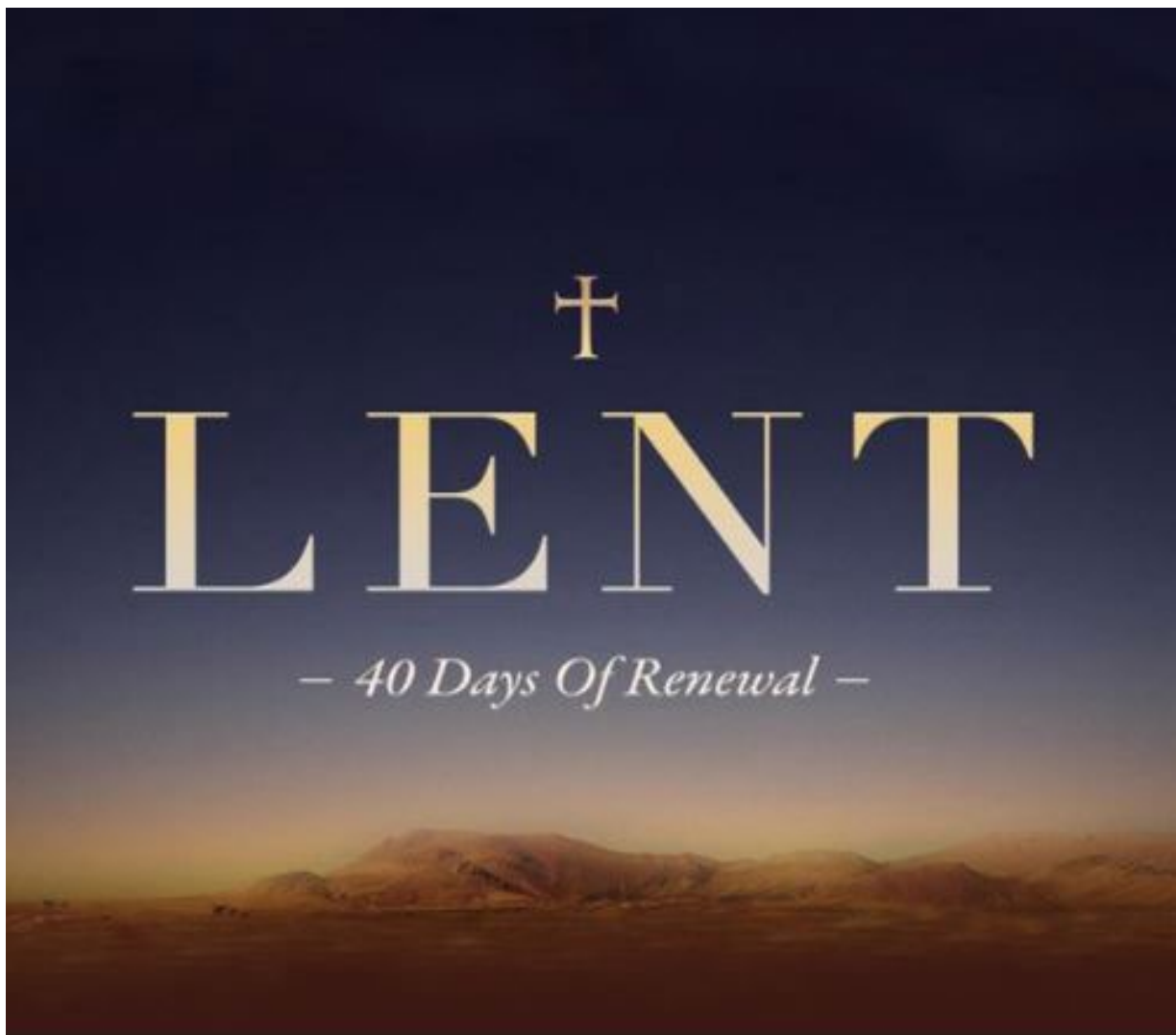

A MESSAGE FROM...

Dear St. James,

When I was asked to write a reflection on Lent, I naturally thought about when I was growing up and how much I disliked this time of year. In our house, it was understood that you had to give something up, something that we really liked, but could do without. Lent was all about Penance and “Oh, how I hated these 40 days.”



Then sometime after Vatican II, for me the Church changed and Lent became not just about sacrifice, but about action. Yes, we could still give something up, but now it was more important to become a better person. For me, this was way more difficult than just giving something up. Now, I had to try to be a better person all the time. I had to overlook someone else's faults, but more importantly I had to recognize all my faults and try to change them. I had to give of my time to help someone in need. I also realized that I had to pray more. I had to talk to God, to remember to thank him for all the little things he does for me every day. When I think about my life, I wonder why I'm still around and why am I so blessed. And I thank him.

Today, I don't hate these 40 days. Along with the other 325 days, I think they are making me a better person and that makes me feel good. Today, the only way I know it's Lent is because I still give something up. I just can't get away from it.

Have a Holy and Happy Lent!

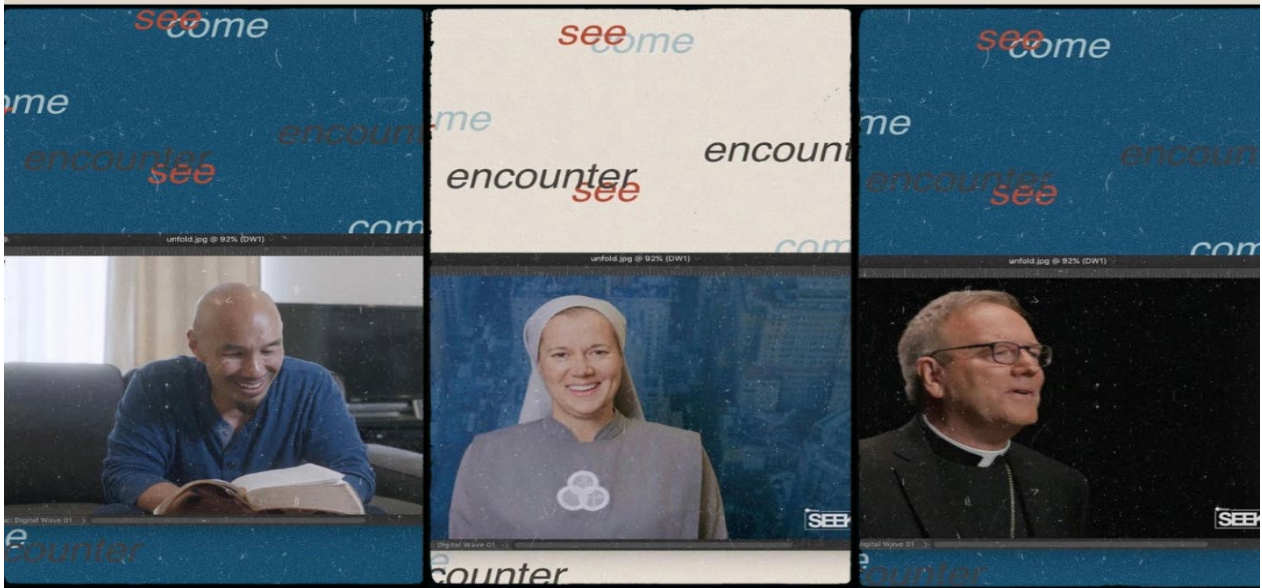

Everyone deserves to be treated with respect and dignity. The Equality Act, which is being voted on in the U.S. House of Representatives soon, in many ways does the opposite and needs to be opposed. Instead of respecting differences in beliefs about marriage and sexuality, the Equality Act would discriminate against people of faith. The Equality Act would: punish faith-based organizations, such as charities and schools who serve everyone in their communities, simply because of their beliefs; force girls and women to compete against boys and men for limited opportunities in sports, and to share locker rooms and shower spaces with biological males who identify as women; risk mandating taxpayers to fund abortions; force people in everyday life, and especially health care workers, to support gender transition; and expand what the government considers a "public" place, forcing even some parish halls to host functions that conflict with Catholic beliefs.

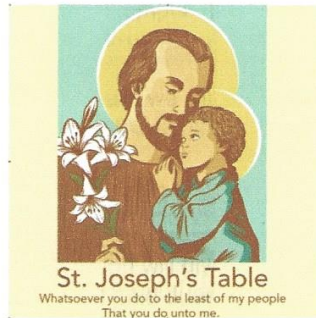

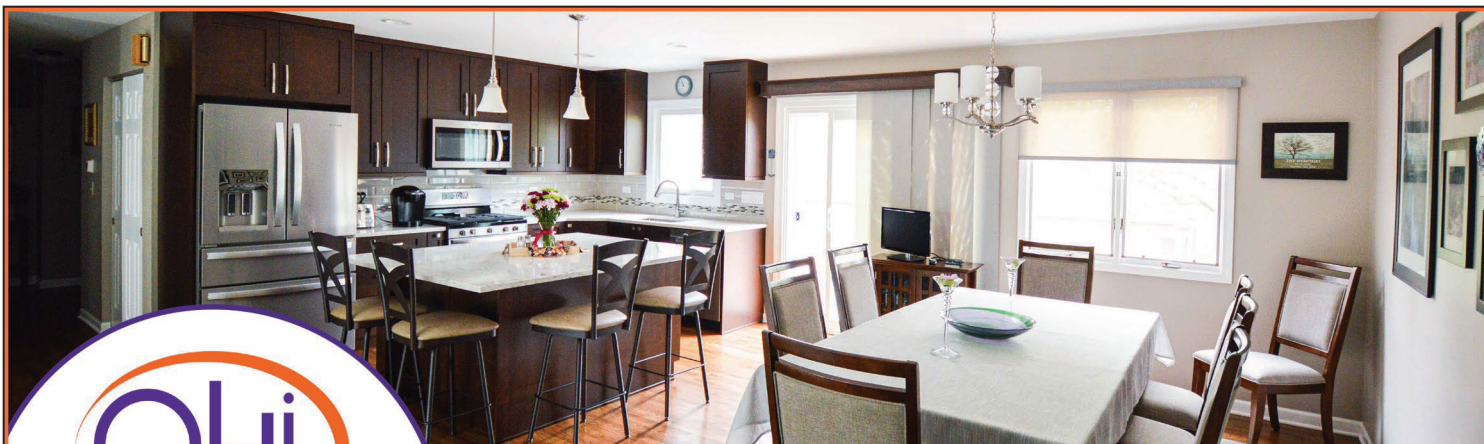
