A MESSAGE FROM...

“My loving Jesus, on this the morning of my ordination to the priesthood, I wish to place in your Sacred Heart, in gratitude for all you have done for me, the resolution from this day forward to go straight for holiness. My earnest wish and firm resolve is to strive with might and main to become a saint.” These words were written by Fr. William Doyle, SJ on July 28, 1907 – the morning he was ordained a priest. With these same words, I begin my own life as a priest.



Fr. Willie Doyle was an Irish Jesuit and military chaplain who died on August 16, 1917 while selflessly rescuing two soldiers from “no man’s land” at the Third Battle of Ypres during World War I. From his youth, young Willie Doyle was known for his extraordinary charity. He would even polish coins to make them look new before giving them to the poor of Dublin. This small and simple gesture was his attempt to give his meager gift greater dignity.

Fr. Doyle spent most of his priesthood giving retreats, hearing confessions and offering spiritual direction across Ireland. After the outbreak of war, he joined the British Army in 1915. So, why does this Jesuit priest – dead over 100 years – mean so much to me? For a countless reasons, but allow me to share just two.

First, Fr. Willie Doyle fulfilled his priestly duties in an outstanding fashion. This was sustained by an ardent spiritual life continually strengthened in Eucharistic Adoration. Second, Fr. Doyle was a ‘regular guy’, who lived extraordinary holiness in an ordinary and attractive way. In doing so, he was able to bring the most hardened anti-Catholics and former Catholics to confession and back into a relationship with Jesus Christ. If only I have a fraction of the holiness and persistence of Fr. Willie Doyle!

I am just beginning my life as a parish priest. In my heart I will carry many great lessons learned at St. James. I am eternally grateful to each of you. You have prayed for me! You have encouraged me! You have made me a stronger man which will allow me to be a stronger priest! The Lord speaks to us – sometimes subtly, sometimes clearly – through each other. I am grateful to have heard the affirmation and love of Jesus Christ through you. Pray that as I begin my life as a priest of Jesus Christ, I may place my own feeble heart in the care of Christ’s Sacred Heart. In doing so, may the Lord polish my heart [like young Willie’s coins] to give greater dignity to my gift to the Church – my whole heart.

May God bless and keep you.
