A MESSAGE FROM...

To my fellow veterans...Happy Veterans Day!

Armistice Day was a day of remembrance for those in the military who had lost their lives in World War One; the hostilities in World War One ceased on the eleventh hour of the eleventh day of the eleventh month (11:00 AM on November 11, 1918). Later, in the mid-1940s, Armistice Day began to include all veterans of the military, not just those that died in World War One. And then in the mid-1950s 'Armistice' was replaced with 'Veterans'



Included in the words President Wilson spoke 101 years ago on the first celebration of Armistice Day on November 11, 1919, were these:

"With splendid forgetfulness of mere personal concerns, we remodeled our industries, concentrated our financial resources, increased our agricultural output, and assembled a great army, so that at the last our power was a decisive factor in the victory. We were able to bring the vast resources, material and moral, of a great and free people to the assistance of our associates in Europe who had suffered and sacrificed without limit in the cause for which we fought."

"With splendid forgetfulness of mere personal concerns..." These words are important to veterans. All veterans, whether they were drafted or served voluntarily, set aside "mere personal concerns" and served others. Shouldn't we as Catholics also take these words to heart and put aside our "mere personal concerns" in service to others? Jesus gives us the answer to that question; specifically Matthew 20:28 - "Just so the Son of Man did not come to be served but to serve and to give his life as a ransom for many."

One of the unfortunate effects of the current pandemic is our inability to reach out and serve in certain ways. Visits to nursing homes and hospitals have been limited; serving the homeless to the best of our abilities has been limited, even the way we celebrate the life of, and mourn the loss of loved ones has been limited. These are just three examples. Many people have mentioned to me that these limitations have been the most frustrating experience over the last several months. Those sentiments are a great testimony to the service mentality...to the "forgetfulness of mere personal concerns..."

Personally, I am very thankful to all the veterans of our great country who "with splendid forgetfulness set aside mere personal concerns." I am just as thankful to the many parishioners of our great parish who "with splendid forgetfulness set aside mere personal concerns" and continue to serve others throughout our community.

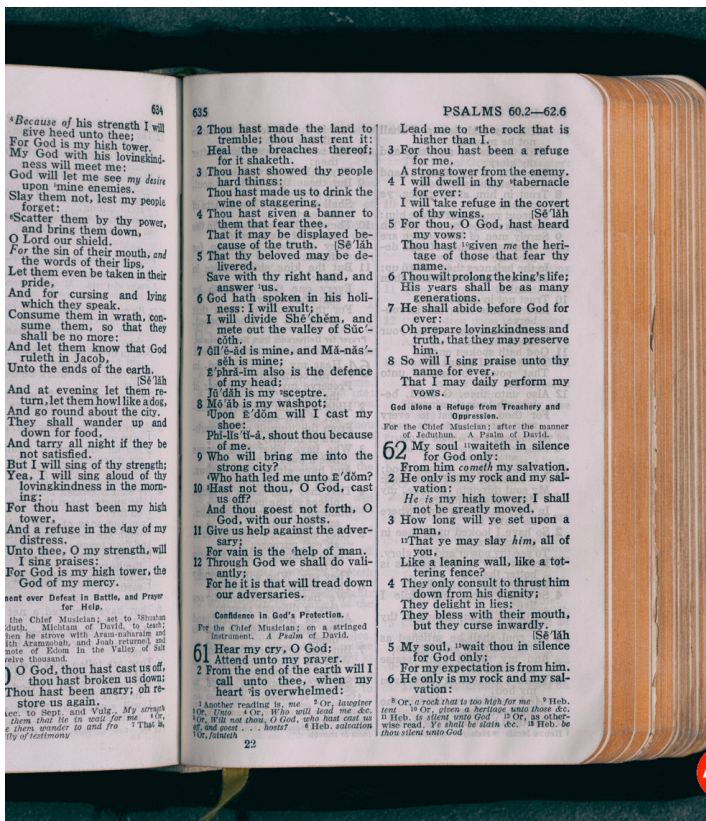

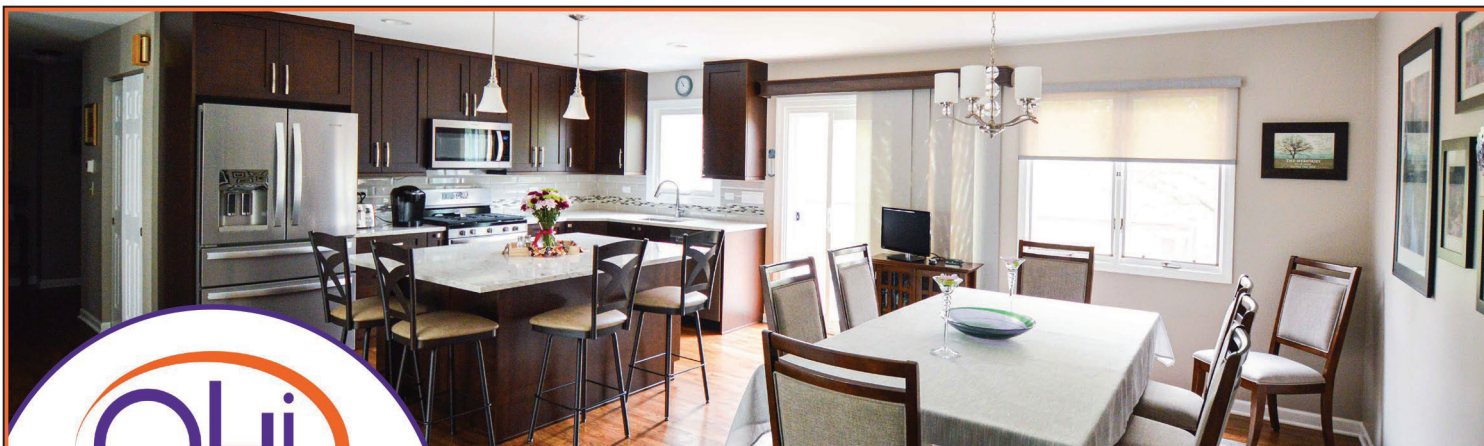
