A MESSAGE FROM....

I was blessed in my early faith journey to hear many talks on the practice of tithing. Yes, I am speaking about the giving of ten percent of my earnings to God and his people. In Luke chapter 6, Jesus commands, "Give, and it shall be given to you. Good measure pressed down, shaken together, running over, will they pour into the fold of your garment. For the measure you measure with will be measured back to you." In 1 Timothy chapter 6 we are told, "Tell those who are rich in this world's goods not to be proud, and not to rely on so uncertain a thing as wealth. Let them trust in the God who provides us richly with all things for our use. Charge them to do good, to be rich in good works and generous, sharing what they have. Thus will they build a secure foundation for the future, for receiving that life which is life indeed."

My story starts out easily enough. As a young, single professional and then when I married, tithing was easy. We were not rich, but we were not financially challenged either. My divorce changed all that. As a newly single mom with four kids ranging in age from 4 to 10 years old, I was suddenly needing to work full time and provide my own health insurance. I was still practicing tithing and knew continuing this discipline was important. My children and I relocated and I was invited by a college friend to come to her church. The opening hymn that day was Table of Plenty. The song says, "God will provide for all that we need, here at the table of plenty." I knew then, deep in my heart, that all would be well.

My first provision from God was a full-time job. I was working for a friend on a part-time basis. When he heard of my need, he immediately offered me a position with benefits. As a devout Catholic, he was also very family-oriented, and I was able to work only when the kids were in school. I could make a good living, have medical insurance, and be given my heart's desire to be with my kids.

As time marched on and I continued tithing, things became financially difficult. The company I was working for closed. Suddenly, I was unemployed. The next couple of jobs were financially challenging and offered no benefits. At about this time, my children were getting older and were offered many opportunities that I could not afford. My youngest son was given the opportunity to travel to Paris with his high school band. One of my very dear friends from church was convicted in prayer that she should pay his way. I had not said anything about my financial situation. She told me one Sunday that the Lord had laid this on her heart and to please not turn her down. I wept tears of joy and relief. God had provided again.

A couple years later, my middle son was returning home from Idaho and needed a car. I was at church, in choir practice, and my seat mate was mentioning how her husband's car was damaged in a hail storm and the repairs for the numerous hail hits were not worth

it. I asked her if they were willing to sell me the car. She checked with her husband and told me the next week that they wanted to just give it to me. Another unbelievable gift. God was working through his people and providing for me and my children.

I believe that my discipline of tithing has resulted in many gifts both spiritual and temporal. I have faith that God will provide. I have a deep sense of peace in God's love for me that surpasses all understanding. I have "received the life which is life indeed." Believe in God, follow his teachings, and experience the gift of peace and life and faith in a loving, nurturing and providing God.

- (1) Interest and Investment income decreased in FY20 due to the expenditure of our savings on the church renovation.
 (2) FY19 had 10 more children enrolled in the school which increased revenue and lowered the parish support.
 (3) In FY20, the Archdiocese increased our target contribution by 2%, from 6% to 8%. We did not make the target contribution.
 (4) FY19 the church was closed for renovation so we were not able to perform as many sacraments.
 (5) In FY19, St. James received a large bequest from a former parishioner.
 (6) St. James Parish added an additional four positions to staff in the areas of evangelization and music/liturgy.
 (7) The school side of the campus underwent a safety repair requiring new concrete and landscaping facing Arlington Heights Road.
 (8) St. James School received a donation of \$132,000 for technology. All was spent on classroom technology for school and RE continuing the move toward one-to-one technology for all students in Kindergarten through Eighth Grade.

STEWARDSHIP REPORT

COMPLETING OUR RENOVATION PLEDGES AND LOOKING FORWARD

Open Our Hearts in Welcome in fiscal year 2020 was focused on working with our parishioners to collect open pledges to pay off the beautiful renovation of our church. As of June 30, 2019, we had open pledges totaling \$2.7M in addition to the cost overrun of \$1.2M. This fiscal year, parishioners contributed \$1.5M to the open pledges, leaving roughly \$1.2M remaining in unpaid pledges. We are very grateful and humbled by your continued support. It is our hope to be able to use these funds for savings and future building needs.

Our next building need has presented itself sooner than we had hoped. The steeple of the church is in a significant state of disrepair. It is crumbling and currently causing a leak into the church and damaging the choir loft. The buildings and grounds committee has asked Wiss, Janey, Elstner Associates, Inc. to assess the steeple. WJE has come back with recommendations and timelines for this repair. We are taking the recommendation to do a temporary fix now and to begin the project in full in Spring 2021. Although we have no solid numbers, the estimate is about \$500K for the entire project.

St. James recognizes the many financial sacrifices made by you, its parishioners. We are immensely grateful for your generosity and commitment not only to the physical needs of the campus but also the mission of the church, to Be Disciples and Make Disciples. We humbly and respectfully request your continued financial help in completing your pledge or giving anew. If you have any questions on how you can help, please contact the business or development offices at the parish. Together we will continue to *Open Our Hearts in Welcome*.

WE RELY ON YOUR SUPPORT... QUALIFIED CHARITABLE DISTRIBUTIONS

Many parishioners who are required to make yearly Required Minimum Distributions (RMDs) have been satisfying their RMD and directly making a charitable contribution to St. James using a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD). A QCD allows IRA owners who are age 70 ½ or older to directly transfer up to \$100,000 annually from an IRA to charity, tax free.

Now during the pandemic, the IRS has waived the RMDs for 2020 via the Cares Act. Therefore, some taxpayers may think that they can no longer (in 2020) make charitable contributions using QCDs, or that doing so will not give them the same tax advantages as before. This is not true. The good news is that taxpayers who could otherwise make charitable contributions using QCDs can still do so.



QCDs will still be excluded from gross taxable income, adjusted gross income and taxable income as before, so taxpayers who are eligible to make QCDs, including those newly eligible ones for 2020, should strongly consider using QCDs for making their charitable contributions to St. James in 2020.

Remember, by using QCDs, and not having to include this distribution in your adjusted gross income, taxpayers can potentially avoid the loss of exemptions, deductions, credits and phase outs, AMT (alternative minimum tax), the 3.8% surtax on net investment income, and the increase in Social Security premiums for Medicare Part B and Part D.

MAKE A GIFT THAT WILL LAST A LIFETIME

Faith Direct is St. James' online giving program. At the end of the previous fiscal year in June of 2019, we had approximately 490 families actively giving through Faith Direct. Those families donated 43% of our offertory, and since the beginning of the pandemic, we have seen an increase of over 140 families giving online through Faith Direct. This has been a huge blessing as we now receive over 63% of our offertory via online donations. Having this more predictable cash flow helps us to better plan how we can serve the community throughout our church and school.

People have many feelings about domestic abuse, especially if it is happening to someone they care about. These are some essential principles of how we can provide support and encouragement:

- Believe the person and tell them you do.
- Listen and validate their feelings, but avoid making judgement.
- Support their decisions and help them build on their strengths.
- Avoid victim-blaming.
- Take their fears seriously.
- Offer specific community information and help.
- Be an active, creative partner in a victim's safety planning effort.

A parish community can and should be an anchor for a victim of abuse.


