A MESSAGE FROM....

September 11, 2001, commonly known as 9/11 seems so long ago and yet still so shockingly disturbing when we recall that infamous day. We held each other tighter and we prayed with greater conviction. Kindness and compassion were uniting forces, not just slogans or calls to action. There was a collective tenderness of the heart of the United States following the terrorist attack and the subsequent mourning as a nation.



In reflecting on writing about 9/11, I found a United States flag in my storage closet and the certificate that I received on my first deployment to Afghanistan. Years later, lives lost and buried, I contemplate where we are as a nation today. My certificate reads:

We thank you for your loyalty, devotion, and sustained support of the War on Terror.
This flag was flown over Bagram Airfield Afghanistan.

Are we loyal, devoted and supporting each other in prayer and action? Are we trusting our God and our neighbors? My wholehearted reply is a resounding yes. As a nation we are still serving in war torn places. As a nation we are still working for justice and peace. As a nation we still hear the laughter of the children and the firm grasp of a grandparent's hug.

We are a resilient and faith-filled people of God. Individually and collectively we know we can be better and do better. We cannot lose sight of the God who created us and the Lord Jesus who saved us. I am blessed to live in a place of freedom and faith. I hope and pray that you and your family share the same sentiments.

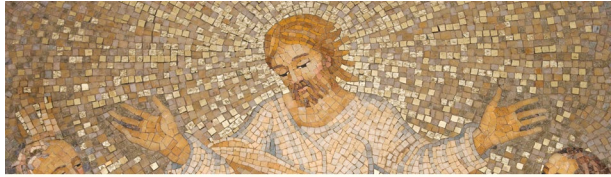
A sanitizing station will be set up in the chapel and we are asking each adorer to clean their space before they leave the chapel. Hand sanitizer will also be provided or please bring your own.

Meeting Mental Illness With Grace



SEPTEMBER IS NATIONAL SUICIDE PREVENTION AWARENESS MONTH

Faith communities provide a natural setting for suicide prevention. Spiritual beliefs and practices can help people experience greater hope and meaning in their lives. Faith communities can also provide opportunities for developing positive relationships with others and can be an important source of support during difficult times.

During Suicide Prevention Awareness Month - and year-round - faith communities can raise awareness of suicide, including its warning signs, how to support those at risk for suicide and where to access help, through flyers, posters, newsletter articles, online classes and other outlets.

Other ways faith communities can make a difference:

- Create a support group for suicide loss survivors - friends and family members affected by the suicide loss of a loved one.
- Have plans in place to respond to people showing warning signs of suicide.
- Offer support to members facing challenges with their relationships, jobs, health, or other concerns.
- Expand options for temporary help for those struggling to make ends meet.
- Encourage members to seek help, and provide referrals to mental health, substance use disorder, legal, or financial counseling services as needed.
- Apply policies that create a healthy environment and reduce stigma about seeking help.

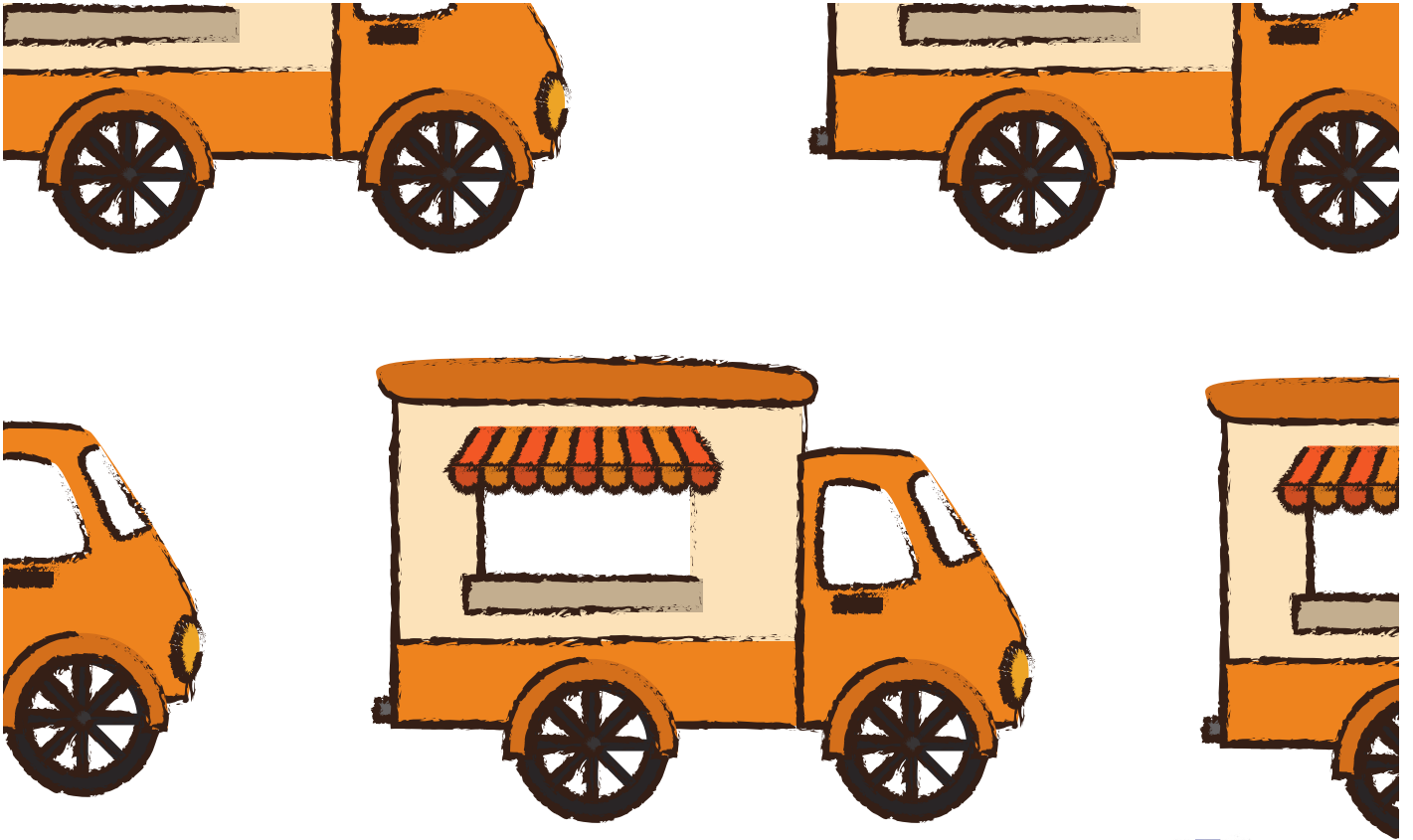
