Today the Church recognizes Catechetical Sunday, a day on which we recognize those who teach our people the Catholic faith. The word catechesis comes from the Greek word meaning to teach orally or by word of mouth.

There is a theme for the day: "Say the Word and My Soul Shall be Healed." Catechists teach the basic message of Jesus Christ, true God and true man, and His life, death, and resurrection; how he, God from eternity, became a member of our race so that he could lead us to eternal life. That basic message is called the **Kerygma**, the apostolic proclamation of salvation through Jesus Christ.



While the first teachers of the faith are parents, our parish like almost every parish, also has a catechetical program which, in partnership with parents, teaches both baptized children and adults entering the Church the basics of the faith.

The children's religious education program at St. James is under the direction of Kevin Byrnes. He relies on the generous service of catechists who offer their gifts to the formation of our young people who attend various public schools. In addition, many of the teachers in the parish school are certified catechists. As well as those who lead those in Faith like the Lifeteen and EDGE Core team and RCIA. I am very grateful for the service of Kevin and our catechists in helping to form our young people as disciples of Jesus Christ.

VETERANS EXITING HOMELESSNESS SUPPLY DRIVE

We've seen the pictures & heard the stories of homeless veterans struggling to regain their footing when returning to civilian life. They risked their lives for us. They need a hand and we can be that hand to them.

The good news is that the Veteran's Administration (VA) has a wonderful rent subsidy program that moves homeless veterans to apartments - with a success rate of over 60% by the 2½ year mark! Please help our veterans by donating items needed to set up a new home!

When a veteran leaves a shelter or transitional housing and moves to a permanent residence, they often do not have the basic items needed to set up their new home. Aside from a need for bedding and furniture, they need the basic items we often take for granted. This collection drive will serve to assist veterans that are moving into a new home. All items will be delivered to a VA facility to be distributed to a veteran in need.

In conjunction with a national veteran's organization (Military Outreach USA), we will be collecting the household items shown below. The VA will distribute 100% of the items collected to service veterans in the greater Chicagoland area by the following week's end. Please help us fill the collection bins.
