Dear Brothers and Sisters in the Lord,

The first reading today is taken from Isaiah chapter 35:

Thus says the LORD:

Say to those whose hearts are frightened: Be strong, fear not!
Here is your God,
he comes with vindication; with divine recompense he
comes to save you.



As we continue to react to the ongoing COVID situation, I believe we need to hear these important words: **Fear not!** God is in charge; He is real and alive; his providence never ends.

There are many who would try to scare us with dire messages designed to bring about fear. Today, the White House press secretary referred to the "thousands of deaths every day" due to COVID while the New York Times reported that last week, August 29, there were zero COVID deaths in the U.S. This is not to minimize the suffering people have experienced, but to honestly look at the real numbers. The Corona Virus is real, and we ought to act cautiously, but stoking people's fear is not helpful.

My heart goes out to all who have suffered and lost family members and friends. We will continue to act cautiously and reasonably. Know that you can always reach out to me or any member of the parish staff if you would like to talk about your concerns or fears.

The Enemy sows fear and division, which leads to isolation. Don't let this divide us. We ask the Lord, who prayed, "that they may all be one; even as you, Father, are in me, and I in you, that they also may be in us, so that the world may believe that you have sent me."

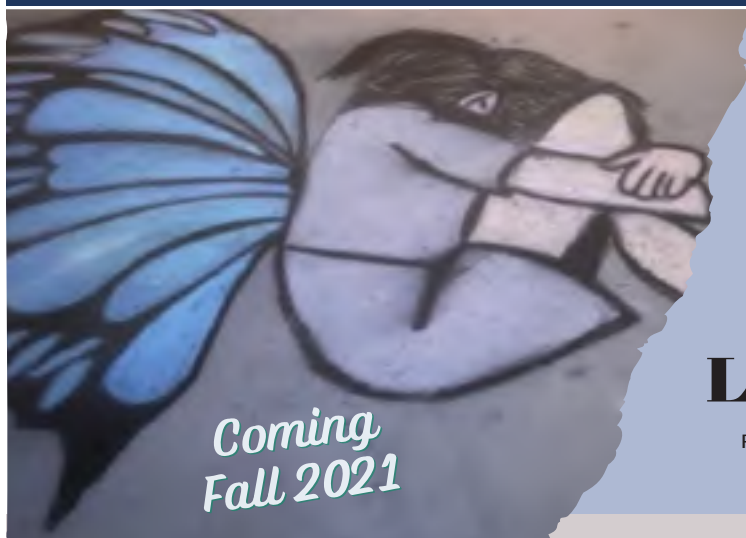
