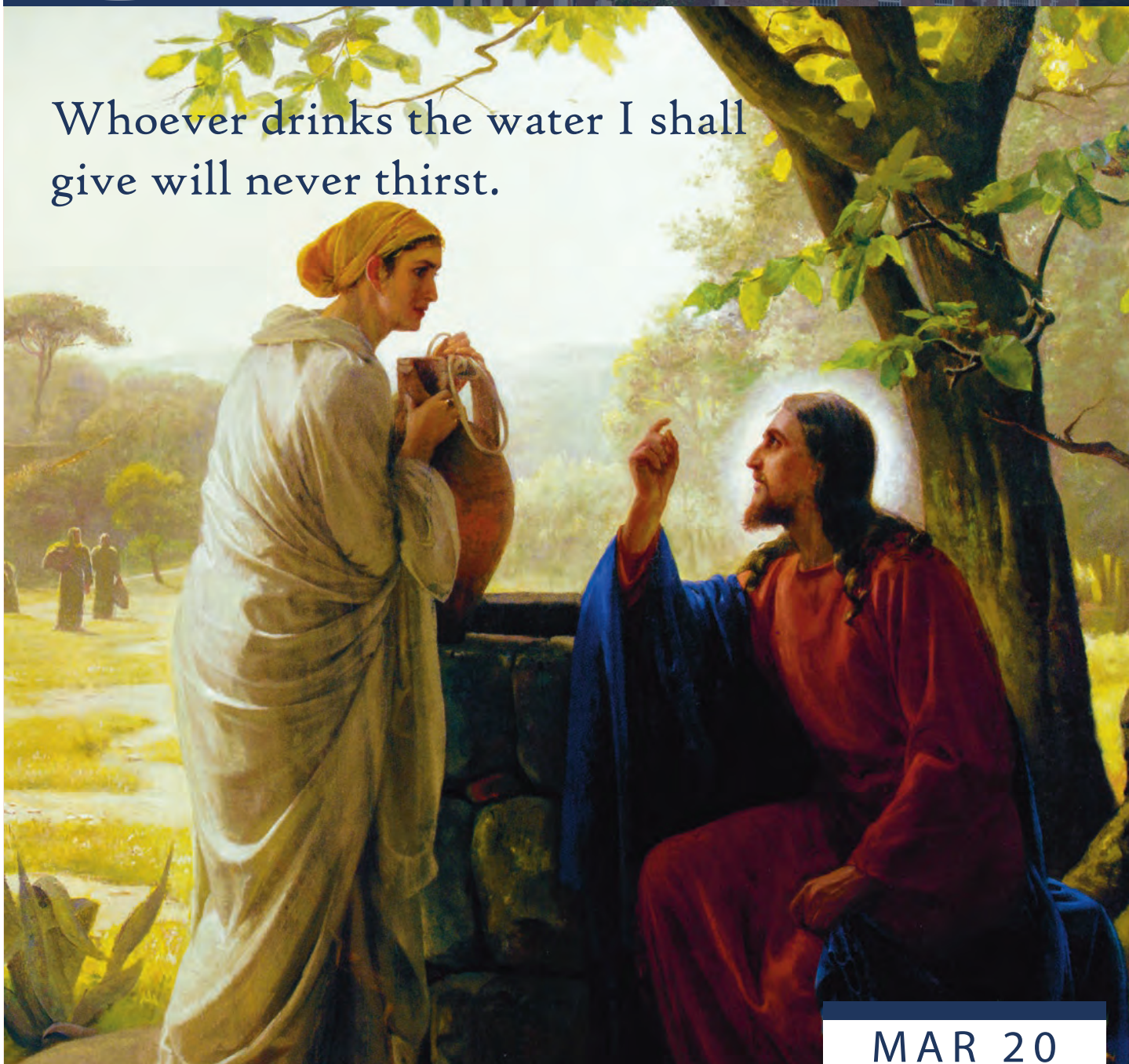

## Today's Readings

### First Reading

The LORD God appears to Moses and directs him to go and deliver the Israelites from Egypt (Exodus 3:1-8a, 13-15) or Exodus 17:3-7.

### Psalm

The Lord is kind and merciful (Psalm 103) or Psalm 95.

### Second Reading

We are not to grumble like the people with Moses in the desert (1 Corinthians 10:1-6, 10-12) or Romans 5:1-2, 5-8.

### Gospel

If you do not repent, you will all perish (Luke 13:1-9) or John 4:5-42 [5-15, 19b-26, 39a, 40-42].



Dear Friends,

“Everyone who drinks this water will be thirsty again; but whoever drinks the water I shall give will never thirst; the water I shall give will become in him a spring of water welling up to eternal life.”

The Samaritan woman meets Jesus at the well and has an amazing encounter with him. She comes to know that he is the long-awaited Messiah and goes back to her people announcing that she has met the Lord.

Jesus wants us to come to know him and receive the life that he wishes to give us, just as he desired the Samaritan woman to receive it.

As we near the midpoint of Lent, we have opportunities to come to know him and love him. Daily mass, Stations of the Cross, opportunities for service to the poor – all these are ways to live out our relationship with the Lord.

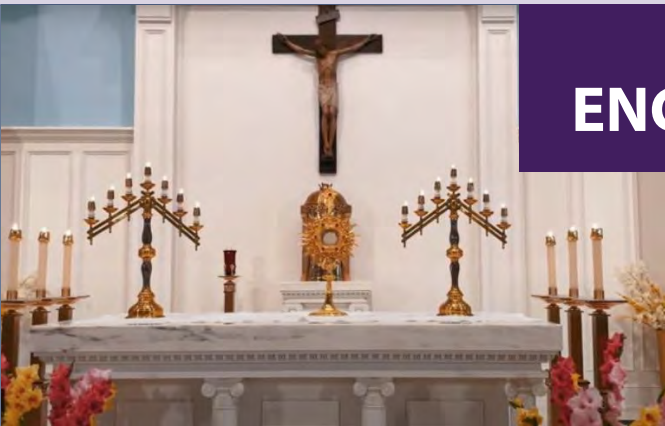
