

Dear Friends,

Today we enter the holiest week of the year. Beginning with Palm Sunday, when we read the entire Passion of the Lord, we then move into Holy Week. What a beautiful week, in which we walk with Jesus through his arrest in Jerusalem, his trial and condemnation, his painful and humiliating carrying of the cross and crucifixion, his burial in the tomb in Jerusalem, and ultimately, his Resurrection from the dead.

Years ago, a woman said to me, "I really don't like looking at that thing."

"What are you talking about?" I asked her.

She pointed at the crucifix and said, "that thing."

My advice to her was simple. "When you feel that way, please pray that the Lord would reveal to you the depth of his love for you."

sacrificed his life for us and for the whole human race so that we might receive his life.

The Jewish people have the High Holy Days. So do we, and they are known as the Easter Triduum.

Triduum consists of Holy Thursday (the institution of the Eucharist and the Priesthood), Good Friday (the crucifixion and death of Jesus our Lord), and Easter Sunday (the joyful day of Jesus' Resurrection).


