Christ is Risen. Indeed He is Risen!*

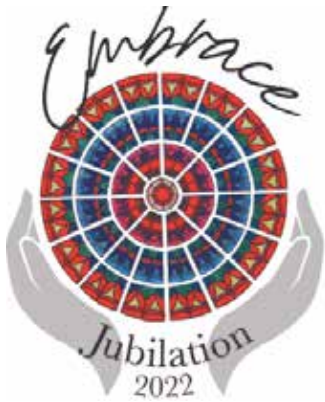

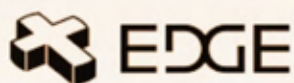
