Still, as I reflect on how the Spirit knew better than I in 2019 as I was led to a phenomenal parish, I can only trust that the same Spirit will continue to be the surest guide.

I simply ask for your prayers in helping me to continue to hear the Spirit in my transition from St. James into my new assignment. Be assured that I will not stop asking the Spirit to continue to guide all of you, my St. James family!




