

#### Men's & Women's Welcome Retreats






April saw two faith retreats at St. James. *Welcome* (formerly known as CRHP) brings adults together for transformative faith sharing.



These illnesses of the brain affect all of us, regardless of age, gender, economic status or ethnicity. Mental illness affects the mind, body and the spirit. It is a real, common and treatable illness. Mental illnesses are far more common than cancer, diabetes, heart disease or arthritis. Our faith communities can be an important part of the re-
