



# "Mary had an indispensable role in our salvation."

Dear Friends,

Happy Mother' Day to all of our mothers. I also think of all those women who stand in for mothers in the lives of so many people. St. John Paul II wrote very beautifully about the gift of maternity and femininity in his encyclical letter Mulieris Dignitatem (the Dignity of Women), pointing out that Mary was at the center of the Incarnation of Jesus. Through Mary, God became man. She had an indispensable role in our salvation. In a beautiful act of love. Jesus gave His mother to us as our mother as he was dying on the cross. Our own mothers share in that motherhood as they bring new life into the world and nurture and sustain it.

Cardinal Ratzinger wrote, "In Mary, as figure and archetype, the Church

again finds her own visage as Mother and cannot degenerate into the complexity of a party, an organization or a pressure group in the service of human interests, even the noblest. If Mary no longer finds a place in many theologies and ecclesiologies, the reason is obvious: they have reduced faith to an abstraction. And an abstraction does not need a Mother. "We honor our mothers and our Mother today.

Congratulations to our First Communicants who received the Body and Blood of Jesus for the first time yesterday. I hope that this is the beginning of a lifelong love of Jesus really present to us in this powerful sacrament.

## WORRIED YOUR TEEN MAY BE EXPERIENCING DEPRESSION?

Living through a pandemic isn't easy on anyone. Whether it's remote learning and drastically different opportunities for socializing, teens are facing major changes in their normal routines or plans for the future. As a result, you may be noticing changes in your teen's mood and behavior. Dr. Gabrielle Roberts, psychologist with Advocate Children's Hospital, says the following signs may suggest your teen is experiencing depression.

1. Frequent sadness, 2. Anger and irritability, 3. Feelings of hopelessness, worth-lessness and guilt, 4. Fatigue, Restlessness, 5. Withdrawal, Loss of interest, 6. Changes to sleep or eating patterns, 7. Trouble with concentration and decision making, 8. Change in school performance, 9. Physical complaints, 10. Suicidal or self-harming behavior

What should you do if you think your child is depressed? What if your teen notices these changes in a friend?

1. Talk with them, 2. Be a good listener: Validate feelings and be careful not to shame or minimize how they feel. 3. For parents, help your child seek help by reaching out to a school counselor, pediatrician or mental health professional. Do not ignore any statements about suicide or self-harm. If your child is threatening to commit suicide, call 911 or go to the emergency room right away. 4. For teens, encourage your friend to seek help. Help them to identify a trusted adult in whom they can confide—like a parent, counselor or teacher. Offer to go with them to talk. If your friend is talking about suicide or engaging in self-harming behaviors, tell an adult right away. Even if your friend might be mad at you for telling, you are being a good friend by taking action to keep them safe. If you are with someone who says they are going to commit suicide, call 911.




