Very recently, it was reported that the US Supreme Court is poised to overturn Roe v. Wade, the 1973 ruling striking down most restrictions on abortion in the US. If this is true, the regulation of abortion would return to the states. This news was learned through a leak from the Supreme Court, which is troubling in itself. The reaction from many who support unrestricted access to abortion has been vitriolic and even violent.

I believe that most Catholics (and others) know what the Catholic faith teaches about abortion. The Second Vatican Council, in the document *Gaudium et Spes*, said this:

"Coming down to practical and particularly urgent consequences, this council lays stress on reverence for man; everyone must consider his every neighbor without exception as another self, taking into account first of all his life and the means necessary to living it with dignity ... Furthermore, whatever is opposed to life itself, such as any type of murder, genocide, abortion, euthanasia, or willful self-destruction, whatever violates the integrity of the human person ... all these things and others of their like are infamies indeed. They poison human society, but they do more harm to those who practice them than those who suffer from the injury. Moreover, they are supreme dishonor to the Creator."*

What is particularly disturbing is that in the state of Illinois, where we have had Catholics serving in key political positions, including big city mayors, state senators and representatives, many aldermen, suburban mayors, and other officials, we have some of the most unrestrictive abortion laws and policies in the nation. What has happened in the past decades that our Catholic values have not influenced the laws of our state?

Life is a beautiful gift. Let us protect it, and cherish it, and give thanks for it. Let us take our faith into the public square, and witness to our neighbors about the love of God and the gift of human life in all its stages, from conception to natural death. Let's pray for all women who have suffered through the trauma of abortion, and support women who are experiencing difficult pregnancies.


The Little Sisters of the Poor at St. Joseph's home in Palatine and their elderly residents are praying for St. James Parish.
