Dear Friends,

These past weeks have been a time of exceptional grace for St. James. Our own Sister Joanne Grib celebrated 70 years of vowed religious life, our second graders received their First Communion at three beautiful masses. At Easter, seven people came into the Church, receiving Baptism, Confirmation or both.

Last weekend, Deacon Dan Korenchan and Deacon Sam Resch were ordained. Yesterday (Saturday), our seminarian Dylan Crawley, who faithfully attended RCIA sessions every Wednesday for the past several months, was ordained to the diaconate in his diocese of Lubbock, Texas. Dylan is studying at Mundelein Seminary but will spend the summer in his home diocese.

Finally, on Thursday and Friday evenings, Bishop Grob was here to administer the sacrament of Confirmation to our young people. The Holy Spirit is real, is active, and abides with us. This is not our work that we are doing, but the work of God. If we cooperate with Him, if we prayerfully discern what comes from God, rather than from the Enemy or simply from our own desires, He will bless the work that we do. God's desire for us is communion. Jesus says in John 14:3 "And when I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and will take you to myself, so that where I am you may be also."

May all that we do bring people to the Lord, that they may enter into the communion which is in the Heart of Jesus.




