Dear Friends,

Jesus has completed his mission. His death, Resurrection, and Ascension have accomplished salvation for all who willingly receive it. A couple of decades ago, the phrase "what would Jesus do?" became very popular. It was shortened to "WWJD?" and could be found on bumper stickers and t-shirts.

I heard a homily given by a priest friend of mine who said the question we should be asking is not "what would Jesus do," but "what did Jesus do?" Jesus continues to carry out this work today through the ministry of the Church.

Before He left us, Jesus gave the Great Commission to His Apostles, a scene which is pictured in the stained-glass window on the south wall of our church.

Jesus said, "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, to the close of the age (Matthew 28:19-20)."

The word "Mass" comes from the Latin dismissal at the end of Mass: "Ite, missa est," that is, "Go, you are sent." Sent out on mission to proclaim what Jesus has done.


