At the very center of our Christian faith is the truth that God is a communion of persons -acommunion of love, into which we are incorporated by our baptism.

Love cannot exist without a Lover and a Beloved. God the Father is the Lover. He sees the Son, who is the Beloved, and immediately loves him. The Son loves the Father in return. That love between the Father and the Son is so powerful and so real that it becomes another Person – the Holy Spirit.


When did you start serving at St. James? Coordinator of Religious Education starting in 2022. Catechist since 2010. Parishioner since 1985.




Fr. Paul Barwikowski


