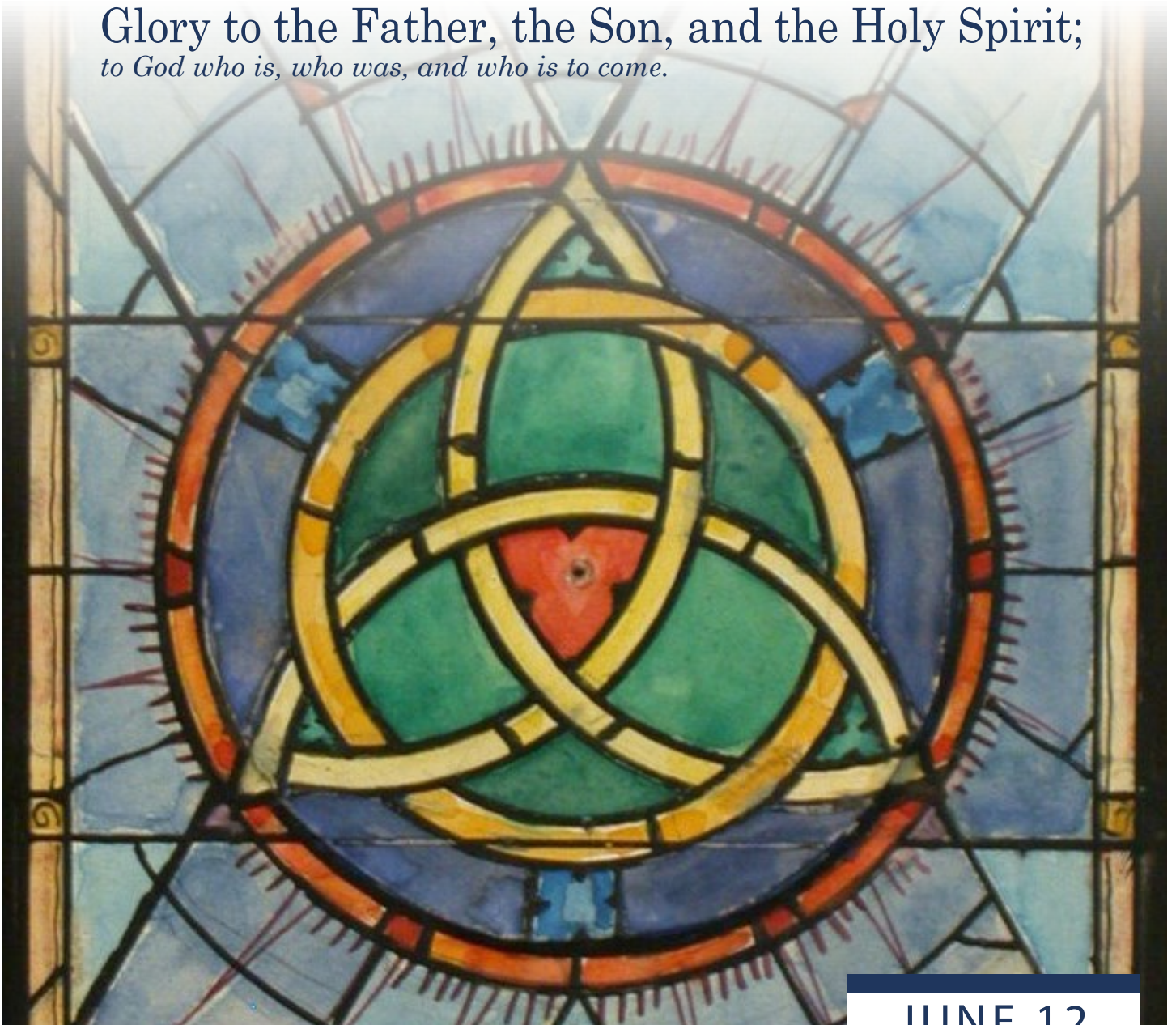

At the very center of our Christian
faith is the truth that God is
a communion of persons – a
communion of love, into which we
are incorporated by our baptism.

Love cannot exist without a Lover
and a Beloved. God the Father is
the Lover. He sees the Son, who is
the Beloved, and immediately loves
him. The Son loves the Father
in return. That love between the
Father and the Son is so powerful
and so real that it becomes another
Person – the Holy Spirit.

This intense relationship of love is
never static, but always dynamic;
is never exhausted, but always
superabundant. Come into that love!

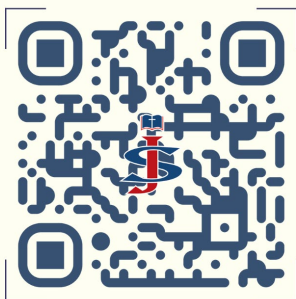

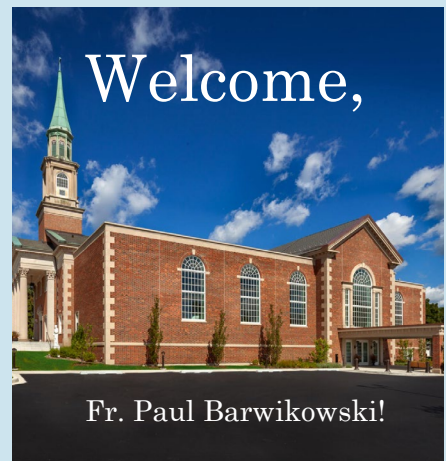


Fr. Paul Barwikowski

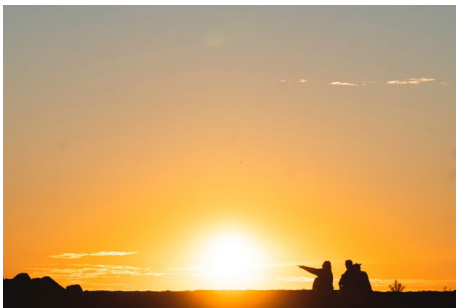
