"This son of mine was dead, and has come to life again; he was lost, and has been found."

Luke 15: 20-24 - While he was still a long way off, his father caught sight of him, and was filled with compassion. He ran to his son, embraced him and kissed him. His son said to him, 'Father, I have sinned against heaven and against you; I no longer deserve to be called your son.' But his father ordered his servants, 'Quickly...take the fattened calf and slaughter it. Then let us celebrate with a feast, because this son of mine was dead, and has come to life again; he was lost, and has been found.'

Today is Father's Day, a day to offer appreciation to our dad, send a card, or get him those really cool socks you know he's always wanted. More important than a gift, though a snazzy tie is always appreciated, is taking an opportunity to tell Dad how much you love him.

A father's love for his children ought to be comforting, reassuring, and powerful. In reality, I know that not all of us have the perfect relationship with our dad. Yet the love that our Heavenly Father has for us is unconditional. Each of us should be assured of this love.

I was blessed with a loving and

supportive dad who modeled for me how to be a father to my own children. Raising a family, especially with energetic and spunky kids like mine, is a challenge beyond any I have taken on in my life. In my experience, however, family life has many rewards and delights that make up for the tough times. It can be difficult in the stresses of daily life to appreciate these moments. I have found that when I take time to pray and see God's hand in our family I am more effective and joyful in my vocation of fatherhood.

One of my favorite Scripture passages is from the parable of the Prodigal Son in the Gospel of Luke where the father runs to meet his estranged son, embraces him and kisses him. This unconditional love that the father had for his son, a son that had left him and squandered his inheritance, is the same love that our Heavenly Father has for us. We are loved, wholly and completely, and God desires for us to be in relationship with Him. May God bless our fathers and may we praise and thank God for his love.


