Dear Friends,

Today's Gospel is taken from the end of the ninth chapter of St. Luke. These words speak to us in a particular way today:

*"Foxes have dens and birds of the sky have nests, but the Son of Man has nowhere to rest his head."*

*And to another he said, "Follow me." But he replied, "Lord, let me go first and bury my father."*

*But he answered him, "Let the dead bury their dead. But you, go and proclaim the Kingdom of God."*

*And another said, "I will follow you, Lord, but first let me say farewell to my family at home."*

*To him Jesus said, "No one who sets a hand to the plow and looks to what was left behind is fit for the kingdom of God."*

I know from my own life, especially in the priesthood, that, "looking to what was left behind," is pretty hard to resist. Leaving a parish is usually painful, because we leave a group of people we have come to love, and who have loved us.

Father Ryan leaves us today, and I know that it is a terribly hard time for him, parting from all those relationships he has formed over the past three years. I also know that many of you have been touched in powerful ways by his ministry as a parish priest at St. James.

Father Ryan welcomed me to St. James and was very helpful in introducing me to the parish in practical ways. He did a wonderful job filling in for me when I was away for some personal time, and I am extremely grateful.

Father Ryan, "safe home," as the Irish say. Safe travels to Rome, and thank you for all you've done for the parish. And please know that you always have a home here at St. James.

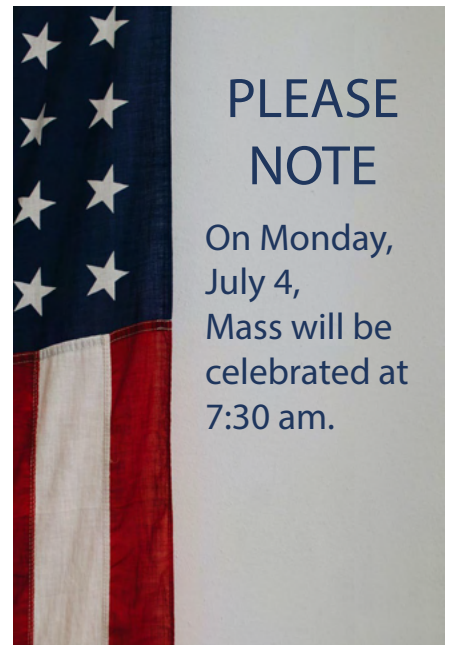
