# "How can we make sense of tragedy? We know that death is not the end."

Dear Friends,

As a nation, we have been hit hard with the tragic massacre of innocent young people and their teachers in Uvalde, Texas. What a tremendous loss of beautiful life at the hand of a deeply disturbed boy. How can we possibly make sense of this?

In the world's terms, it cannot make sense. In our Christian view of life and death, however, there is at least some comfort. Where was Jesus when this tragedy was unfolding? Was he standing and watching, not intervening? Did he care?

I suggest we look at the Cross. Where was Jesus? He was dying with those children and their teachers. He is weeping with their parents and families, and we know that their death is not the end.

Ellie Garcia, a 9-year-old victim of the shooting, had posted a video online days before she died. In the video she said, "when we die, we will be with Christ." Some would scoff at this, accusing us Christians of believing in, "pie in the sky when we die." But we know that this is true. Jesus walked our walk, lived our life, died our death, was raised from the dead, and offers new and eternal life to those who believe in Him.

Jesus sent the Holy Spirit to the Church on that first Pentecost to empower the Apostles and all the baptized to bring this Good News to all the world. This is the Good News which can bring comfort to the sorrowing and hope to those who despair.

Paul Claudel, a French poet and dramatist, once wrote, "Jesus did not come to explain away suffering or remove it. He came to fill it with His Presence."

I pray that the Holy Spirit, poured out upon those first disciples, will pour out His power upon us as well, so that we will know that Presence.

#### **ASSOCIATE PASTOR APPOINTED**





Fr. Paul Barwikowski

#### Help Us Expand Our Reach This Summer


