# A MESSAGE FROM...

Dear Friends,

In the movie Indiana Jones and the Last Crusade archaeologist Jones goes on a quest to find the Holy Grail (the chalice Jesus used at the Last Supper). In a memorable scene, a Nazi agent, Dr. Elsa Schneider, dies while grasping at a jeweled chalice she believes is the grail. She grasped it not out of devotion, but out of greed.

Today's Gospel is a stark warning to us. What is most important to us? What is valuable to us – and is it what matters to God?

Last week, Pope Francis went to Canada to meet with Native Canadians in order to acknowledge and apologize for sins against their people in residential schools committed by members of the Church in collusion with the Canadian government. Sadly what is often lost in the narrative is the truth that Catholic missionaries first and foremost brought the beautiful truth of Jesus Christ to the people of Canada.

Dr. Jeff Mirus on the Catholic Culture website shared this reflection:

"If someone cannot understand the

incredible beauty and joy of the life of the Mohawk Indian Saint Kateri Tekakwitha, that person is not equipped to properly evaluate the work of the Catholic Church, the reasons for her existence, her fundamental mission, and what really constitutes the sins of her members.

As members of the Church, we sin frequently; that goes without saying. We should apologize quickly and sincerely to all whom we harm by our sins, for our sins always create problems. But nothing creates human problems like the refusal on all sides to see the surpassing goodness of the Church as the Body and Bride of Jesus Christ—our Savior, our Redeemer, our Way, our Truth, and our very Life."

What is the fundamental mission of the Church? To preach the Gospel of Jesus Christ – that all human beings, from the womb until natural death, are created in the image and likeness of God, are redeemed by Jesus Christ, and are invited into an eternal, joyful life with Him.

## Saving a Mother's Life in a High Risk Pregnancy

### The Principle of Double Effect Applies

when it's not possible to save both mother and baby  
(e.g., ectopic pregnancy or cancerous uterus)

Surgery may be allowed that doesn't directly attack the preborn baby's life, even if it leads to the foreseen, but not intended, loss of preborn life when other alternatives are not available.

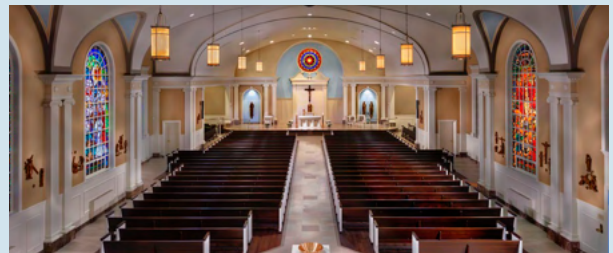
