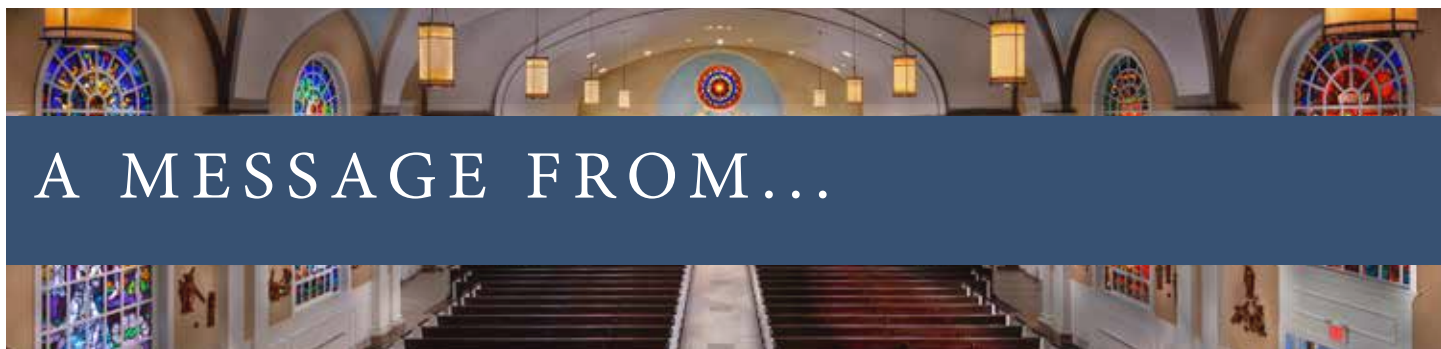

Philip found Nathanael and said to him, "We have found him about whom Moses in the Law and also the Prophets wrote, Jesus son of Joseph from Nazareth." Nathanael said to him, "Can anything good come out of Nazareth?" Philip said to him, "Come and see."

John 1:45-46

Through Philip's invitation, Nathanael came to know and follow Jesus. "Come and see" was the invitation. The same invitation is offered today to those who are seeking a deeper relationship with God. In a few weeks, we will begin our Catechumenate/RCIA process for those who wish to explore the Catholic faith. RCIA stands for Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults. Over a period of several months, candidates and catechumens gather weekly to explore the Catholic faith in depth, in preparation for reception of the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and First Communion at Easter.

Catechumens are those who have not been baptized, and candidates are Christians of another denomination who were baptized Christian at some point in their life who wish to become Catholic. If you are feeling a call to come into the Catholic Church, or would just like to come and see, you are welcome. If you are a Catholic who would like to explore our faith more deeply, you are also welcome. If you know of anyone whom you think

might be interested in exploring the faith, please invite them.

I knew a young man who was very involved as a volunteer in our youth ministry at Queen of the Rosary. He graduated from QR School after completing 10 years from preschool to eighth grade, and was a participant in youth ministry during his high school years. When he got married, he and his wife were looking for a religion to join. I told him there was no question about what religion he should be. I said he should become Catholic. I asked him why never entered the Catholic Church, and his response was "no one ever asked me."

Come and see. Jesus is waiting to welcome you. Please contact me if you would like to be a part of this or if you know someone who would like to.



Dear Friends,

Greetings to all. We want to thank Father Ed, Father Paul, Deacon Matt and many sponsors from St. James parish who helped us to celebrate the twentieth anniversary of the Foundation for Children in Need on Friday, August 12th at St. James Parish in Arlington Heights, Illinois. Nearly 250 supporters gathered in the church to thank God for the many blessings poured out upon Dr. Geetha and Tom Chitta, Founders of FCN, and FCN supporters. Fr. Ed celebrated the Mass and Fr. Matt Foley preached the homily. Beautiful singing was led by Raeghan Graessle, a long time FCN supporter.

FCN was founded in 2002 in Arlington Heights to provide an opportunity to share blessings with those in need in India. Today, FCN sponsors 2000 children and college students enabling them to continue their education. FCN Home lovingly and compassionately cares for the most impoverished elderly and physically challenged individuals free of charge.

After the Mass, everyone gathered in the parish center for a lovely reception and dinner. Several sponsors shared their experiences and encouraged others to continue to sponsor the children. Fr. Bill shared about his trip to India. There was an outpouring of love and appreciation for the outstanding work done by FCN. All had a wonderful time! Tom and Geetha expressed deep gratitude to the entire St. James Parish Community, to Nancy and Pat Moroney and Donna and Tim Wheeler who organized the event and those who provided food for the event and made the celebration a grand success!
