# A MESSAGE FROM...

## Today's Readings

### First Reading

In spite of violence, destruction, and ruin, the just person, because of faith, will live.

(Habakkuk 1:2-3; 2:2-4)

**"So do not be ashamed of your testimony to our Lord, nor of me, a prisoner for his sake; but bear your share of hardship for the Gospel with the strength that comes from God."**

2 Timothy 1:7

St. Paul is writing to St. Timothy from prison in Rome, where he has been placed by the Roman authorities. Because Paul is a Roman citizen, he has certain rights, and the Romans can't just kill him for preaching the Gospel. But I believe that Paul knew that he would be executed for the faith eventually, and he was preparing Timothy to continue the work of preaching the Gospel of Jesus.

"With the strength that comes from God." St. Paul encourages Timothy to rely on this. The strength that comes from God. This strength is real and powerful, but it sometimes looks like weakness to the world. But for us baptized Catholics, this strength is powerful and real and effective.

I see many signs that we are most likely going to undergo a persecution of our Catholic faith in the US. The hostility to the gift of life, particularly through abortion,

infanticide, and euthanasia, the mutilation of our precious young people through transgender surgery and the propaganda surrounding it, the celebration of sexual confusion, the rejection of the poor, the stranger and the refugee – all these things deny the real Truth – that we are all beloved sons and daughters of a loving Father. This is rejected by so many in our society and our government.

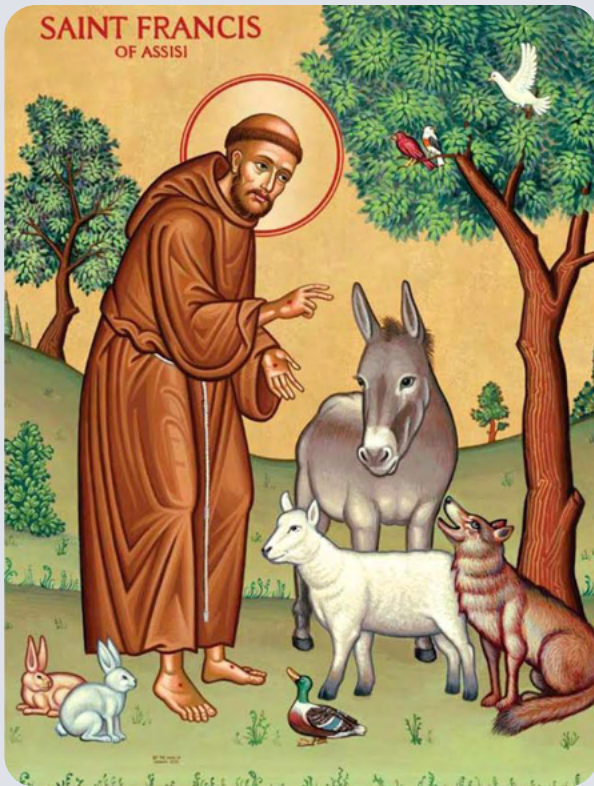
As baptized Catholics, we have been set apart to proclaim the truth in season and out of season, and to be witnesses and beacons of light in this world.

We must not despair or fear. God is with us, as he was with St. Paul in prison. Let's keep praying that our loving Father will sustain us in all we do.

The Loaves & Fishes Ministry provides an evening meal and a brown bag lunch for women at Sarah's Circle and men at North Side Housing. Our ministry operates every Saturday beginning in October and continues through the last weekend in April.

Numerous St. James groups prepare lunches and meals, and many families and individuals make lunches, pick up soup and bread and give up their Saturday evenings to deliver food to the shelters. Thanks to all who have helped in the past.

## Public Action to Deliver Shelter

Saint James hosts a Wednesday to Thursday overnight shelter for our local homeless community. Members of the Saint James community provide a hot dinner, warm place to stay, breakfast and a lunch to-go the next morning. All guests are registered and vetted through the PADS organization.

### We need your help!

Please consider donating your time alongside others who are called to serve.

### PADS Shifts

The PADS site is open October– April. Training will be provided. The PADS program asks that all volunteers be vaccinated.

#### Set-Up Shift

- Set up beds and bedding before the shelter opens its doors

#### 1st Shift 7:00pm – 9:00pm or 11:00pm

- Sign-in PADS guests and take lunch orders for the next day
- Help PADS guests with laundry and showers

#### 3rd Shift, 3:00am – 7:00am

- Breakfast (no cooking involved)
- Wake up guests for 7 am departure

#### Food Team

- Join a team in preparing and serving food for the homeless guests

#### 2nd Shift, 11:00pm – 3:00am

- Make lunches for the next day
- Supervise and be there for PADS guests

#### Clean-Up Shift, 6:30am – 7:30am

- Clean areas used by guests
  - Put sleeping pads and bedding away
- \*Service hour opportunity for older children with a parent\*

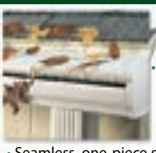
