St. Paul sums up the Church's mission with these words to Timothy. In the heart of God the Father is a desire for eternal communion with us. Flowing from this desire is his revelation of Himself through Jesus, who is the Truth. Jesus says to Thomas, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father, but by me." John 14:6.

On this Catechetical Sunday, these words from Paul's letter to Timothy and Jesus' words in John's Gospel take on new urgency. Our catechists in the Religious Education program and our teachers in St. James School are carrying out the commission given by Jesus to take the Gospel and the sacraments to all nations. This Great Commission begins here within our parish.


Celebrating Women Mass

This event is open to all adult women, so plan to bring the women who are special in your life!








An Invitation for New Parishioners


