Dear Friends,

Naaman the Syrian was converted to faith in Yahweh after his miraculous healing from leprosy at the hands of the prophet Elisha. His whole life changed through this encounter with the living God.

As believing Catholics, our lives are fundamentally changed by our relationship with God, who has revealed Himself to us through His son Jesus. We can no longer pay homage to any other god except to the Lord. And yet there are many Catholics who do pay homage to another god. In this Respect Life month, the enshrinement of abortion as a moral good and a basic human right comes to mind. It is inconceivable that a believing Catholic disciple of Jesus Christ would consider the killing of innocent human life as anything other than a grave moral evil, or what Vatican II called an "unspeakable crime."

Yet this is not just a dogmatic (or faith inspired) belief. It is a conclusion drawn from moral reasoning and from the findings of objective science. Bishop Robert Barron, addressing the issue of abortion, calls it "the most pressing moral issue of our time." He raises the very reasonable question of how believing Catholics, foremost among them some of our prominent political leaders, can hold the incoherent position that what they profess by their Catholic faith as gravely immoral can at the same time be promoted with impunity.

Please pray for the conversion of our nation. And please pray for all victims of abortion, especially grieving mothers.


#### We Remember

Carpooling is encouraged! We will meet at the St. James parking lot at 8:45 am.






