Dear Friends,

Naaman the Syrian was converted to faith in Yahweh after his miraculous healing from leprosy at the hands of the prophet Elisha. His whole life changed through this encounter with the living God.

As believing Catholics, our lives are fundamentally changed by our relationship with God, who has revealed Himself to us through His son Jesus. We can no longer pay homage to any other god except to the Lord. And yet there are many Catholics who do pay homage to another god. In this Respect Life month, the enshrinement of abortion as a moral good and a basic human right comes to mind. It is inconceivable that a believing Catholic disciple of Jesus Christ would consider the killing of innocent human life as anything other than a grave moral evil, or what Vatican II called an "unspeakable crime."

Yet this is not just a dogmatic (or faith inspired) belief. It is a conclusion drawn from moral

reasoning and from the findings of objective science. Bishop Robert Barron, addressing the issue of abortion, calls it "the most pressing moral issue of our time." He raises the very reasonable question of how believing Catholics, foremost among them some of our prominent political leaders, can hold the incoherent position that what they profess by their Catholic faith as gravely immoral can at the same time be promoted with impunity.

Please pray for the conversion of our nation. And please pray for all victims of abortion, especially grieving mothers.

Numerous St. James groups prepare lunches and meals, and many families and individuals make lunches, pick up soup and bread and give up their Saturday evenings to deliver food to the shelters. Thanks to all who have helped in the past.

Public Action to Deliver Shelter

Saint James hosts a Wednesday to Thursday overnight shelter for our local homeless community. Members of the Saint James community provide a hot dinner, warm place to stay, breakfast and a lunch to-go the next morning. All guests are registered and vetted through the PADS organization.

We need your help!

Please consider donating your time alongside others who are called to serve.

PADS Shifts

The PADS site is open October– April. Training will be provided. The PADS program asks that all volunteers be vaccinated.

Set-Up Shift

- Set up beds and bedding before the shelter opens its doors

1st Shift 7:00pm – 9:00pm or 11:00pm

- Sign-in PADS guests and take lunch orders for the next day
- Help PADS guests with laundry and showers

3rd Shift, 3:00am – 7:00am

- Breakfast (no cooking involved)
- Wake up guests for 7 am departure

Food Team

- Join a team in preparing and serving food for the homeless guests

2nd Shift, 11:00pm – 3:00am

- Make lunches for the next day
- Supervise and be there for PADS guests

Clean-Up Shift, 6:30am – 7:30am

- Clean areas used by guests
 - Put sleeping pads and bedding away
- *Service hour opportunity for older children with a parent*
