A MESSAGE FROM...

Today's Readings

First Reading

The barren deserts will rejoice and flower. Tired bodies will receive strength. Aching hearts will be made glad.

(Isaiah 35:1-6a, 10)

Psalm

The Lord saves us when he comes.

(Psalm 146)

Second Reading

Be patient, for the coming of the Lord is as sure as the rain.

(James 5:7-10)

Gospel

Tell of what you hear and see: The blind regain their vision, the crippled their movement, the deaf their hearing.

(Matthew 11:2-11)



"Rejoice in the Lord always; again I say, rejoice..."

...Let your forbearance be known to all, for the Lord is near at hand; have no anxiety about anything, but in all things, by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be known to God."

This is the entrance antiphon for the Mass of the Third Sunday of Advent. It is based on Philipians 4. The first words of the antiphon in Latin are *Gaudete in Domino*. Hence, this Sunday is traditionally called Gaudete Sunday.

"Are you the one who is to come, or should we look for another?" From his prison cell, John the Baptist sends his disciples to ask Jesus that question. Jesus makes it clear that the answer is, "yes, I am the one."

In James 5, we are given this encouragement, "Make your hearts firm, because the coming

of the Lord is at hand." To repeat the words of St. Paul in the antiphon: "Have no anxiety about anything, but in all things, by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be known to God."

God has not abandoned His people. His salvation is coming. He has a deep desire for each of us, his beloved sons and daughters.

Rejoice in the Lord always, especially as we enter these final weeks of preparation for Christmas. The best way to prepare is to receive the reconciliation of the Lord in the sacrament of Confession. There are numerous opportunities this coming week in our multi-parish penance services. Please come and receive the Lord's peace.

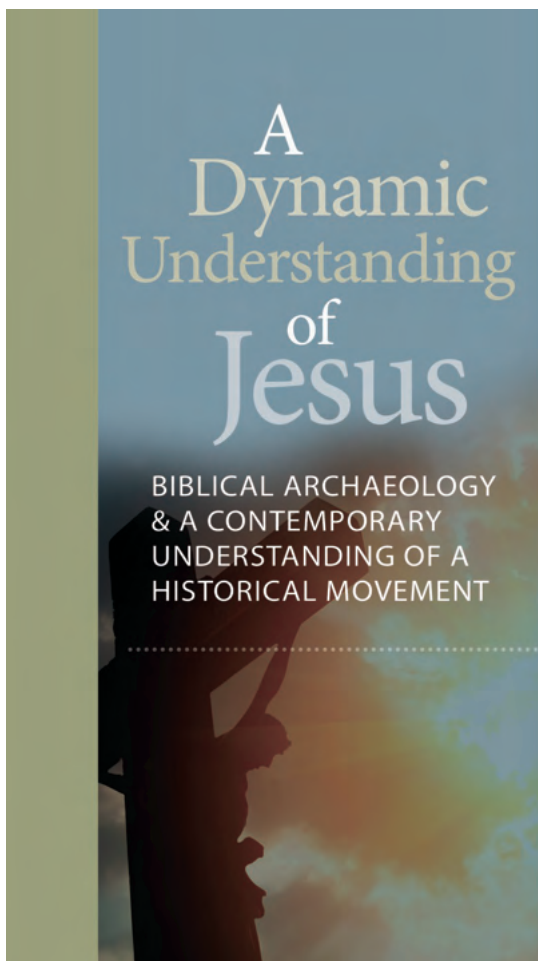
FORMATION OPPORTUNITIES

This past year, John Camardella took a sabbatical from teaching to complete a graduate degree in religion at Harvard Divinity School. As part of his research, he traveled to Israel and Palestine with the biblical archaeology program and partnered with the Israeli Antiquities Authority to excavate a recently discovered site in Galilee.

- Help loved ones figure out how to handle some of the stress of family gatherings (i.e. how to answer tough questions during family time, identify a task to focus on during gatherings, how long to stay, places to go to take breaks etc...).
- Set boundaries around time spent on holiday tasks. An afternoon shopping at a couple stores is more manageable than a full day at the mall.
- Prioritize quiet time with God by creating a special holy space with a candle, cross or picture to connect with Jesus.

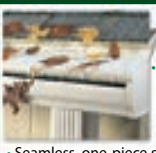
