Yet Mary remains silent. She keeps
all this news about her son to

herself. She reflects on all these
experiences. The only thing she
shares is the name of her son, Jesus,
a name given him before he was
even conceived. Her silence leaves
us wondering if this is how one
responds to such a great blessing.

FORMATION OPPORTUNITIES

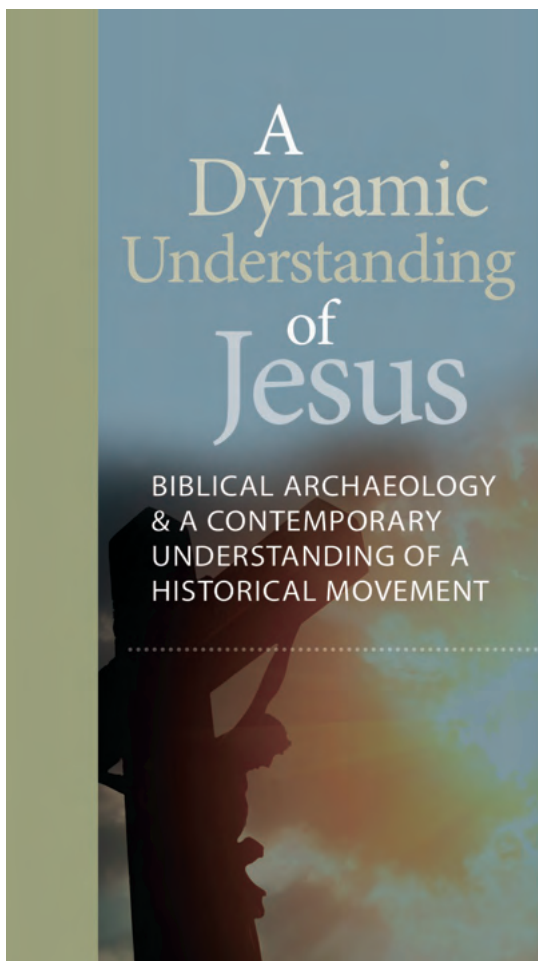

WEEKLY STEWARDSHIP RECOMMENDATION

Reduce car idling to save money and reduce pollution.

Unnecessary vehicle idling wastes six billion gallons of fuel per year, contributing to smog and air pollution according to the US Dept. of Energy. These emissions make air unhealthy, especially for children and elderly people, and increase the likelihood of global warming.

Except in traffic, turn the engine off if you'll be static for more than 10 seconds, especially while running an errand, waiting for someone, or at a long stop like a railroad crossing. With modern engines, idling is actually harder on your engine than shutting it off.

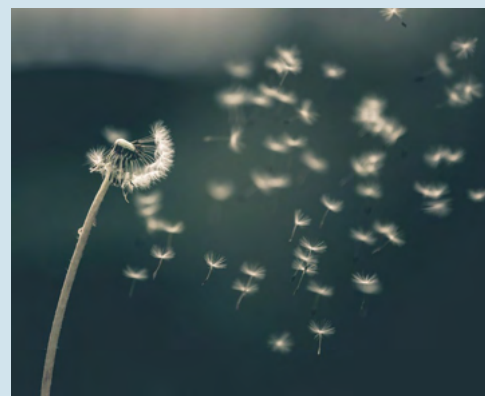
Even in the winter don't idle a cold engine for more than 30 seconds because engines warm up better by being driven gently.

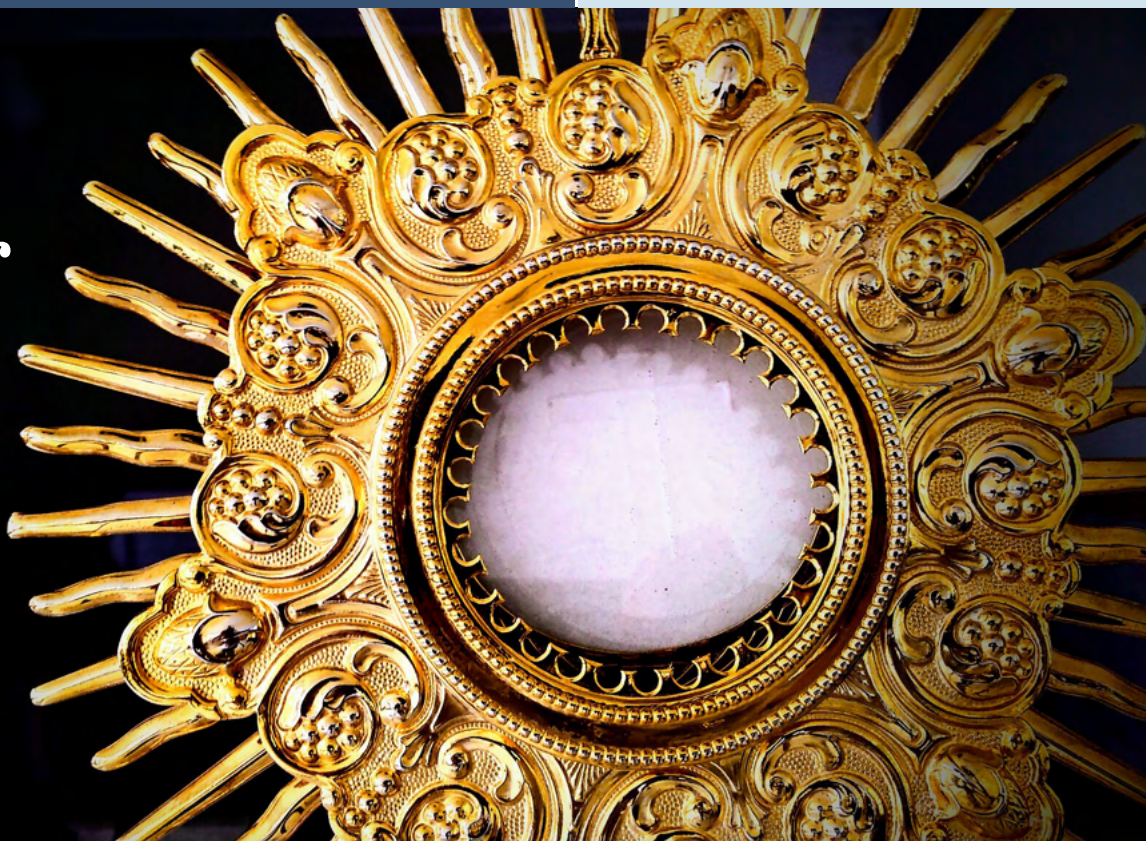
