

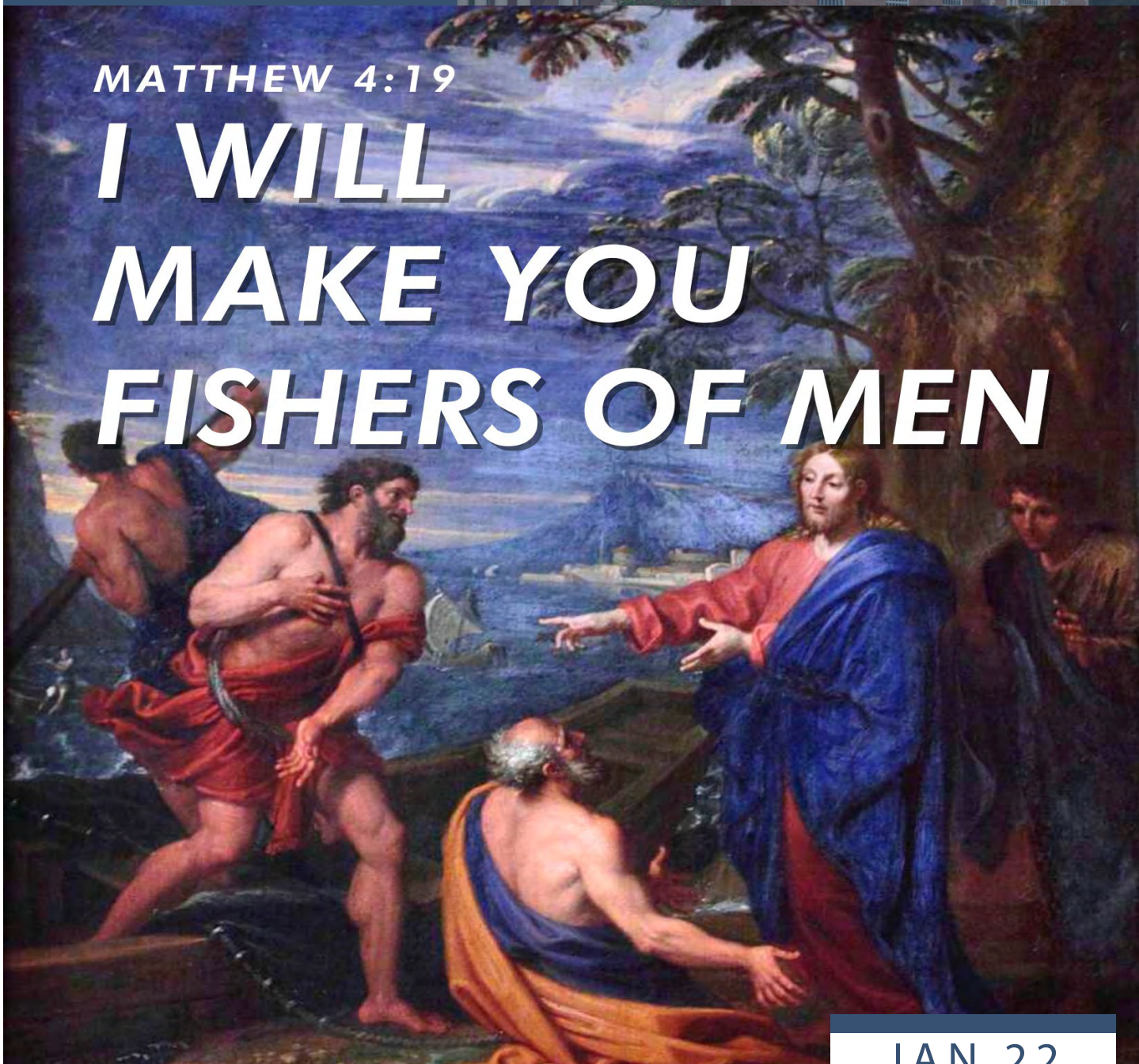

On June 24, 2022, the U.S. Supreme Court overturned *Roe v. Wade*, the Supreme Court decision of January 22, 1973, fifty years ago today, which struck down all state laws outlawing abortion. Regulation of this gruesome procedure was returned to the states. In the years since *Roe v. Wade*, there have been an estimated 63 million abortions in the United States alone.

On December 2, 1965, the Second Vatican Council's pastoral constitution on the Church in the modern world, *Guadium et Spes*, described abortion and infanticide as "unspeakable crimes." And yet there are numerous professedly Catholic political leaders and legislators who promote abortion as a basic human right. Tragically, many of those Catholic politicians are right here in Illinois, which today has some of the most permissive abortion laws in the nation.

Our work still lies before us: to continue to promote a culture of life in our state so that abortion becomes unthinkable to our people. Life is a beautiful gift, not an inconvenient burden. Women in difficult circumstances need our love and support, and victims of abortion, both mothers and fathers, must receive healing and forgiveness.

Thank you to those who work so dedicatedly for the promotion of the dignity and protection of fragile new life, particularly the members of our Respect Life group.

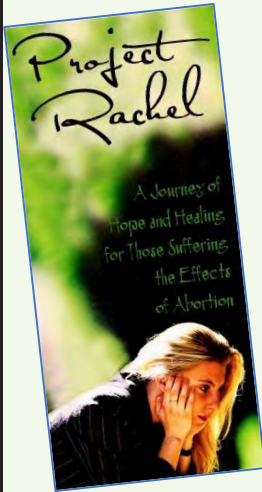

There are many times when we do not have a regularly scheduled person to run the slideshow for us during our weekend Masses.


