

This Trinitarian blessing from St. Paul to the Corinthians shows an understanding of God as a communion of Persons which was present at the very beginning of the Church. This understanding was developed and expounded upon in subsequent councils of the Church.

Jesus has revealed to us the reality of our God with a dynamic inner life, the life of the Lover, the Beloved, and the Love between them, which we call the Trinity. We baptized Christians are invited into that life through the sacraments.

We begin all of our prayers in the name of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit. We are baptized and absolved in the name of the Trinity. We are blessed at the end of Mass in the Trinity. In the greatest act of love, on the Cross and in each Mass, Jesus offers himself to the Father

in the power of the Holy Spirit. The one true God, in three Persons, exhanges love in a most beautiful way, and invites us in.

Holy Communion Under Both Species

Returns Next Weekend at St. James

The public health emergency attributable to the COVID-19 pandemic expired on May 11. Consequently, the Archdiocese of Chicago is lifting all COVID-related restrictions in our churches, including the restriction on communal reception of the Precious Blood from the Chalice.

In a recent statement to clergy and staff, the Archdiocese notes, "Though the health emergency is over, we must continue to respect each other's preferences regarding personal health and safety. ... Some ministers or parishioners may be uncomfortable receiving the Precious Blood from the Chalice. In all situations we must act prudently and charitably

toward each individual and the entire assembly."

At St. James, we are reinstating the offering of Holy Communion under both species on Corpus Christi Sunday, June 10-11.




