




Dear Friends,

On this beautiful feast of Corpus Christi

- the solemnity of the Body and Blood
of Christ - we honor and cherish the
gift of the Holy Eucharist, the Real
Presence of Jesus Christ, God himself,
body and blood, soul and divinity.

In the Eucharist, the sacrifice his life by God the Son to God the Father is made present to us on the altar. The sacrifice of the Cross and the sacrifice of the altar are one and the same. So great is God's love that he invites us into this exchange of love, this exchange of persons.

We approach the sacrament with awe as we prepare to be one flesh and blood with the Lord. If we receive Communion worthily, powerful grace is poured into us.

Every Communion we receive is an intimate encounter with the God who created and sustains us, who laid down his life for us and was raised from death

for us. So awesome is this gift that some Christians cannot accept it, and cannot believe that he is really and truly present, much like the disciples who walked away from Jesus when he talked about eating his flesh and drinking his blood.

O Jesus, I truly believe that you are present, Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity, in this Holy Communion. May it bring me not condemnation, but health in body and soul.




