Dear Friends,

The American bishops have called for a national Eucharistic Revival "to inspire a movement of Catholics across the United States who are healed, converted, formed, and unified by an encounter with Jesus in the Eucharist." We will be making several initiatives – in preaching, education, formation, prayer and liturgy – over the coming year. These efforts are in the planning stage at the moment.

The Church, in Sacrosanctum Concilium, Vatican II's Constitution of the Sacred Liturgy, calls the Eucharist the "source and summit" of the Church's life. Everything flows from the Eucharist and leads back to it. The offering of the Eucharistic Sacrifice is the most powerful act of worship we can enter into.

Yet there is clearly a problem in how this is being lived out in the Church. Many people lack a true understanding of the reality of the Eucharist – that it is, first of all, the re-presentation in the present moment of Jesus' self sacrifice on the Cross. Second, Jesus Christ is truly present – Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity, under the forms of bread and wine, after the consecration of the mass. In light of this, the Church is trying to draw people into a renewed Eucharistic faith, so that when we receive Communion, we are more aware of WHO we are receiving – God Himself.

The climax of this Eucharistic revival will be the 10th National Eucharistic Congress. Join your Catholic brothers and sisters as we encounter the living Jesus Christ, experience profound renewal, and are sent out on mission for the life of the world. The Congress will be held in Indianapolis July 17-21, 2024 at Lucas Oil Stadium in Indianapolis. I am excited that a group from St. James will be attending. Look for details in the coming days and weeks.

# PADS Overnight Shelter Reopening This Fall

### Volunteers are needed to serve the unhoused in our area.

After being closed as an overnight shelter during Covid, there is a need to reopen the doors of the church to the vulnerable and unhoused in the area. The renovation of St. James Church was thoughtfully outfitted to offer a soft place to land on a weekly basis from October through April. We are grateful to be able to offer showers, laundry, and warm meals. This is only possible with consistent, generous support from the community.

St. James PADS will reopen October 2023. We are in need of many volunteers this season. If you worked with PADS in the past, please come back and continue to nourish the spirit of those in need and mentor new volunteers. If you have not volunteered before, please join one of our volunteer teams, and check with your friends to see if you would like to work together on a shift. Many parishioners and others in the community have formed lifelong bonds with their fellow volunteers through this program. Serving others is a connection like

no other. The commitment can be as small as four hours per month or as often as you are available.

Shift Volunteers work on either the 1st, 2nd, 3rd, or 4th Wednesday of the month covering 4-5 hour shifts from 7:00 pm -7:00 am. During this time the volunteers monitor and serve the needs of the guests with showers, sleeping arrangements and laundry. Shift Volunteers must be 18 or older, or 16 with a parent. New volunteers will have access to a brief training.

**Food Teams** sign up for either the 1st, 2nd, 3rd, or 4th Wednesday of the month to provide and/or serve warm dinner for the guests (signing up to drop off either an entrée, side, or dessert from a given menu).

There will be additional opportunities for small groups, scouts, youth groups, community groups, teams, ministries, etc.





The 2023-24 WOSJ Ministry Year kicks off in August with small group meetings beginning in September. Larger "all-ministry" events & service projects are held throughout the year.






