

PADS Overnight Shelter Reopening This Fall

Volunteers are needed to serve the unhoused in our area.

After being closed as an overnight shelter during Covid, there is a need to reopen the doors of the church to the vulnerable and unhoused in the area. The renovation of St. James Church was thoughtfully outfitted to offer a soft place to land on a weekly basis from October through April. We are grateful to be able to offer showers, laundry, and warm meals. This is only possible with consistent, generous support from the community.

St. James PADS will reopen October 2023. We are in need of many volunteers this season. If you worked with PADS in the past, please come back and continue to nourish the spirit of those in need and mentor new volunteers. If you have not volunteered before, please join one of our volunteer teams, and check with your friends to see if you would like to work together on a shift. Many parishioners and others in the community have formed lifelong bonds with their fellow volunteers through this program. Serving others is a

connection like no other. The commitment can be as small as four hours per month or as often as you are available.

Shift Volunteers work on either the 1st, 2nd, 3rd, or 4th Wednesday of the month covering 4-5 hour shifts from 7:00 pm -7:00 am. During this time the volunteers monitor and serve the needs of the guests with showers, sleeping arrangements and laundry. Shift Volunteers must be 18 or older, or 16 with a parent. New volunteers will have access to a brief training.

Food Teams sign up for either the 1st, 2nd, 3rd, or 4th Wednesday of the month to provide and/or serve warm dinner for the guests (signing up to drop off either an entrée, side, or dessert from a given menu).

There will be additional opportunities for small groups, scouts, youth groups, community groups, teams, ministries, etc.

WOSJ also offers **Moms Plus**, a small group for moms, where new and experienced moms gather to share the ups and downs of the journey of motherhood.





Pope Francis' message for

World Day Of Prayer For The Care Of Creation

September 1, 2023


Pope Francis urges us to, "seek first the kingdom of God," (Mt 6:33) maintaining a right relationship with God, humanity, and nature so that justice and peace will flow. Francis tells us to act now with greater urgency, so we do not miss our chance to create a more sustainable and just world. "We can and we must prevent the worst from happening." An, "ecological conversion," is needed.

This idea is not new. Saint Pope John Paul II encouraged us to embrace, "the renewal of our relationship with creation so that we no longer see it as an object to be exploited but cherish it instead as a sacred gift from our Creator." We are challenged to be mindful, "about our habits and economic decisions so that all can thrive" using resources with moderation and a joyful sobriety, recycling waste, and making use of available products and services that are environmentally and socially responsible.

Francis reminds us we must listen to science and institute a rapid and equitable transition to end the era of fossil fuels. "Truly, much can be done" (LS, 180).







Deepening our relationship with God, being more present for those we love and expanding our prayer life for the benefit of all.

Together, we will explore and practice prayers of emptying and surrender. We will learn how to focus our attention, and unite mind, body, and spirit in the service of God and others.


