




If you could read just one book...

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

If I could recommend just one book to help someone in the spiritual life – after the Bible, of course – it would be *The Story of a Soul: The Autobiography of St. Thérèse of Lisieux* (the Little Flower). A relatively short read, it is the one book I have bought and given away more than any other; I currently don't own a copy.

St. Thérèse desired to be a missionary, proclaiming the Gospel of Jesus Christ in foreign lands. However, her vocation was to the cloistered convent of the Carmelites. In the process of her discernment, she realized that her vocation was to be love at the heart of the Church.

It is love that fuels the missionaries in their evangelistic efforts. As a person whose life was dedicated to prayer, her life was to intensely love Jesus, especially in prayer and in the Carmelite community. The fruits of that life would be a channel of grace for the Church and her missionary work.


While she would not be doing a great "work" in the sense of literally risking her life for Jesus in foreign lands, she would do great "works" by doing small actions with great love. She writes, "Miss no single opportunity of making some small sacrifice, here by a smiling look, there by a kindly word; always doing the smallest right and doing it all for love." She also wrote: "Our Lord does not so much look at the greatness of our actions, or even at their difficulty, as at the love with which we do them." This was her "little way."

If you are single, have a family, or are retired, and wonder what great thing God has for you to do, then consider St. Thérèse's little way in your life.

PADS Reopening This Fall

Volunteers are needed!

St. James PADS will reopen October 2023. We are in need of many volunteers this season. If you worked with PADS in the past, please come back and continue to nourish the spirit of those in need and mentor new volunteers. If you have not volunteered before, please join one of our volunteer teams, and check with your friends to see if you would like to work together on a shift. Many parishioners and others in the community have formed lifelong bonds with their fellow volunteers through this program. Serving others is a connection like no other. The commitment can be as small as four hours per month or as often as you are available.

Shift Volunteers work on either the 1st, 2nd, 3rd, or 4th Wednesday of the month covering 4-5 hour shifts from 7:00 pm -7:00 am. During this time the volunteers monitor and serve the needs of the guests with showers, sleeping arrangements and laundry.

Shift Volunteers must be 18 or older, or 16 with a parent. New volunteers will have access to a brief training.

Food Teams sign up for either the 1st, 2nd, 3rd, or 4th Wednesday of the month to provide and/or serve warm dinner for the guests (signing up to drop off either an entrée, side, or dessert from a given menu).




Donation for Ukraine


