

Psalm 68 is proclaimed at Mass today:

God, in your goodness, you have made a home for the poor.

The father of orphans and the defender of widows is God in his holy dwelling.

God gives a home to the forsaken; he leads forth prisoners to prosperity.

In the blessing of a newly married couple there is an option which has always spoken beautifully and profoundly to me. It reads:

May you be witnesses in the world to God's charity, so that the afflicted and needy who have known your kindness may one day receive you thankfully into the eternal dwelling of God.

We hear often about the need for humility, and we hear it again today from the prophet Sirach: "Humble yourself the more, the greater you are, and you will find favor with God."

Along these same lines we hear this exhortation from Jesus, "For every one who exalts himself will be humbled, but the one who humbles himself will be exalted...when you hold a banquet, invite the poor, the crippled, the lame, the blind; blessed indeed will you be because of their inability to repay you. For you will be repaid at the resurrection of the righteous." (Luke 14:14).

The St. Vincent de Paul Society, PADS and our Peace and Justice Ministry are such apostolates in the parish who, supported by so many of you, make the love of God real and present to those in need. Fr. Paul Barwikowski

Welcome to our new Associate Pastor, Father Paul.

ather Pawel
Barwikowski was
born in Pisz, Poland
in January, 1988. In 2007,
he became a seminarian of

the diocese of Elk, Poland where he completed the first three years of the priesthood formation. In 2009, he was transferred to Bishop Abramowicz Seminary located in Chicago. While he was leaving Poland to come to Chicago, the Bishop of the diocese of Elk said to him, "I'm letting you go, because the Church is universal. Serving in Poland or in the United States, you will still be serving the same Church."

With the permission and blessing of his bishop, Fr. Paul joined the group of three men that came to Chicago in 2010. In 2011, he was accepted into Mundelein Seminary. He was ordained a Priest of the Archdiocese on May 21, 2016.

After ordination Fr. Paul served two different communities, both in Chicago. His first assignment was St. Andrew Parish located in the Lakeview neighborhood. After seven months he was transferred to St. Constance Parish where he spent five years serving as an Associate Pastor and Administrator. In 2021, Fr. Paul joined St. Clement Parish as Associate Pastor where he spent some time discerning his next step in ministerial priesthood. In July, Cardinal Blase Cupich appointed Fr. Paul to our own St. James Parish.

He says, "it is with a full heart, and a heart on fire, that I express my gratitude to Father Ed and all of you for welcoming me as a new member of your parish community. I believe this experience will help me to become a better version of myself.

I come from a big family - three brothers and three sisters. So, there was always a ton of young people around. With my family experience it is my great joy that I can be serving the community of St. James where there is so much going on.

Dear sisters and brothers, please pray for me as I already remember you in my priestly prayers. May God bless us all!"

THIS WEEK'S STEWARDSHIP RECOMMENDATION: Celebrate the Season of Creation

The Season of Creation is a month-long prayerful observance that calls upon Catholics to pray and care for God's Creation. It starts September 1st and ends October 4th . It's a time to reflect on our relationship with the environment, how we live, and how our lifestyles impact the natural world, humans and other creatures inhabiting it. This "time for creation" offers, in the words of Pope Francis, "individual believers and communities a fitting opportunity to reaffirm their personal vocation to be stewards of creation, to thank God for the wonderful handiwork which he has entrusted to our care, and to implore his help for the protection of creation..."

The US Conference of Catholic Bishops reminds us that "we show our respect for the Creator by our stewardship of Creation". Pope Francis urges us to recognize our connectedness with the natural world saying, "Nature cannot be regarded as something separate from ourselves or as a mere setting in which we live. We are part of nature, included in it and thus in constant interaction with it."(LS 139). Advocating for Creation Care helps safeguard the inheritance the Creator has given us, an inheritance essential to our well-being. Pope Benedict XVI told us that protecting this inheritance is a way of fulfilling our role as stewards of Creation.

COST

The ticket from Chicago to Hyderabad and from Delhi to Chicago will be approximately \$1,200 to \$1,400 depending on the sales. The earlier you book the cheaper it will be. Three flight tickets in India, from Hyderabad to Kadapa, Kadapa to Chennai and Chennai to Delhi will be approximately \$200.

Tom and Geetha will host you at Hyderabad and Kadapa. Visit to the projects and sight-seeing transportation expenses will be about \$200 for a week both in Hyderabad and Porumamilla. In Delhi and Chennai, you will stay in hotels. In these places you will pay as you go along for food, accommodations and transportation expenses. It will cost approximately \$100 per day for transportation, food and hotel in Chennai and Delhi. Hotel cost is for twin occupancy; single room will cost extra.

Geetha and Tom will receive you at Hyderabad and travel with you the entire trip.

Visiting India is a once-in-a-lifetime experience. We welcome you to join us.


